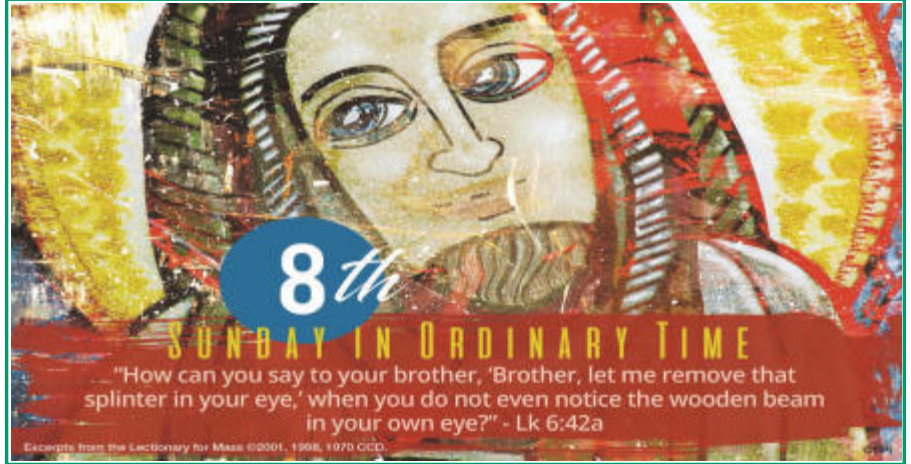

Pastor's Message



Again in today's gospel Jesus uses His well-worn technique with parables. Cynthia Cowen gives us insight on Jesus' use of parables in His teachings. Jesus taught by using simple stories to illustrate a moral truth. They are called parables. Jesus' parables were fictitious short stories used to set forth a teaching. It is estimated that the number of parables in the gospels is as low as 35 and as high as 72. The variation arises from the difficulty in classifying them. Yet one thing is certain, the parables come from Jesus himself. In order to get a real picture behind the parable we need to compare two parables with a similar motif. We use Luke 6: 47-49 and Matthew 7:24-27. Both speak about building on rock or solid ground. To appreciate this parable, we should understand that where Jesus was preaching, rains come seasonally. In recording this parable, we must remember that Luke was not a native of Palestine so consequently did not have a clear picture of the circumstances described. Matthew did. Being a Palestinian, he knew just what the picture was. During the dry season, there is prime real estate to be had. But the buyer needs to beware! When the rivers of summer dried up altogether, they left a sandy bed of empty water. In the winter, after the September rains had come, the empty river bed became a raging torrent. Those inviting stretches of sand may have looked good, but after the rains they may be fifty to sixty feet under water. Jesus said that the wise man searched for rock upon which to build. It may have been harder to build on, but it was worth it. When the storms of winter came, he would be rewarded for all the hard work. His house stood strong and firm and secure. In form, Luke's or Matthew's, this parable teaches the importance of laying the right foundation for life; the understanding that the only true foundation is obedience to the teaching of Jesus. The other value of parables is that one can glean often more than one meaning or understanding or interpretation of it. Looking again at today's parables, how might you interpret Jesus' parables?

STAFF MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The following are highlights from the Staff Meeting held February 20, 2019

- **Guests:** The following from Falcon Bank gave a presentation to the Staff and also brought lunch. Those present were: Virginia Hepburn, Sandra A, Knapp, Luisa R, Havestadt, Hugo Gutierrez
- **Doug:** Reminded the staff that the sound system box for the wireless and ambo microphones is restricted to Lucy, Doug, Tony and Msgr. Mike. Someone got into the facility and altered the settings. No one except those listed above is to change these pre-set settings.
- **Deacon Ray:** Tuesday (26) of next week, we commence refurbishing the restrooms in the Church. The replacement of all 12 toilets will be the thing that will happen first; followed by the replacement of counter tops, lighting and finally the strip and waxing of the floors...We will strip and wax all floors in the Faith Formation. That is scheduled on Friday March 1st...He is starting to take bids to power wash buildings where the "black mold" has developed. Also we will replace the broken gutters that caused the water to stain our walls. He has reached out to Risk Management to see if this would be covered under our insurance and apparently they are calling it normal wear and tear; so we, as a Parish are responsible... We must address an issue that has gotten worse and worse. All ministries and staff must be made aware that whenever they use one of our rooms, that they should leave it the way they found it...or better. We do not have enough maintenance staff to take care of this. He will address this again to the ministries in his weekly schedule email, but this pertains to all staff as well. We must have a "team" for set up and breakdown; PLUS clean up. This is an understanding that really should be unspoken. We have a great Parish and people are willing to help, they just need to be asked. Msgr. Mike and Deacon Oscar have previously made it clear that if this policy is not followed said Ministry may lose their privilege to use facility. We may need to start enforcing it if this continues.
- **Renee: Confirmation 2:** We have been using a new curriculum from Augustine Institute called Y-disciple. It has been well received by the core team and the youth. We will continue to test this material as it is broad and gives us an opportunity to have excellent materials at the level our youth are ready to receive it. We have emailed the parent letters to families and shown them how to access the materials through Formed.org utilizing our parish subscription...**Alive in the Spirit Retreat** took place this past weekend and was well attended with over 100 high school youth. We had 18 college mentors and 12 young adults who participated in giving the retreat for our students. The youth also responded very well to the prayer teams of young adults and 4 adult mentors. All of our youth felt the priests being available for confession to start the retreat made their hearts more open to going deeper with Christ...**Mexico Mission:** Sending forth mass will be March 2nd at 5pm. Donations of children's toys and candies are being collected...**2:42 Lifeteen Meeting:** Thursday 2/21 10-1pm she will be attending along with other youth ministers, priest and music ministers in our diocese.
- **Mike:** We are currently at 4,666 registered families with a total of 14,352 members. These are active families which mean the either contribute to the upkeep of the parish financially or are registered through Faith Formation.
- **Debbie:** The Knights of Columbus have again asked that the teens help with the Habitat House so we have Humanity Day on April 13. - **Kristin: Sacramental Preparation:** The last parent/child workshop will be on Saturday, March 23rd at 9:00 am in the church. This will be a "Slow Motion" Mass with or three priests present and Lucy will be doing the music and a parent will do the reading. How many EMs should we have? Gaby and Eric will be giving the children a taste of the bread and wine in the Ministry Room after the Mass is completed...The children preparing for First Eucharist were given a booklet to complete during Lent. They will be asking various ministers (EM, music, altar server, greeter, presider, deacon) each week to sign their booklet as part of the assignment. This assignment will begin on March 6...First Communion Weekend is scheduled for May 4/5. We have 186 children who are preparing for First Communion this May. Children can celebrate First Eucharist at any of the regular weekend Masses on that particular weekend except at the 11:15 on Sunday morning. (There a Men's ACTS returning that time). We are adding one additional Mass on Saturday, May 4th at 11:00 am for the celebration of First Eucharist as well.
- **Eric:** Our next Holy Hour will be on Thursday, March 7th (EXALT) at 7pm...The Young Adults will be serving food for Habitat for Humanity (Holy Trinity) on Saturday, March 9th...We will also be helping with the Habitat Build (St. Mark) on Saturday, March 16th...We have begun meeting for our young adult retreat which will be held the weekend of April 12-14th. The retreat center will be at Sanctus Ranch in Pipe Creek, TX. Cost is \$75/person and registration will open this week.
- **Gloria:** Ministry Appreciation Dinner is set for Wednesday, May 8, 2019, theme this year "We Are Wild About You"
- **Msgr. Mike:** Reminded the Staff for the donation and/or pledge for our Believe, Belong and Beyond campaign by the end of February 2019...Ash Wednesday is a very busy day with attendance.

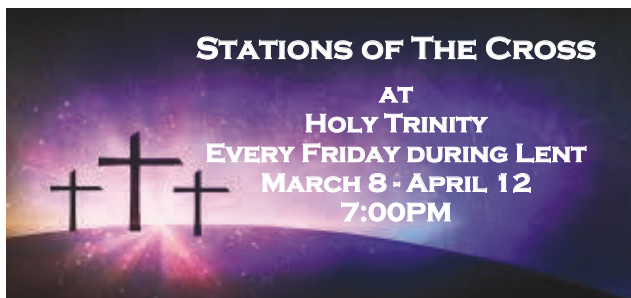

LAW OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question:

Is Ash Wednesday a holy day of obligation?

Answer:

Despite the often packed churches, you may be surprised to hear that the answer is no! Holy days of obligation commemorate a particular event (such as the birth of Christ at Christmas) or celebrate particular people (such as Mary's Immaculate Conception or the feast of All Saints). Ash Wednesday is a day of penance, fasting, and abstinence to begin the season of Lent. In a sense, it focuses on a concept rather than something particular and concrete.

Of course, repentance ought to be reflected in particular, concrete ways! That's one of the reasons that attending Mass on Ash Wednesday is a very good idea. It marks the beginning of a solemn season of penance. Despite all its comparisons to the desert, Lent can be very fruitful for our spiritual growth! Beginning this season with the celebration of Mass and the reception of ashes is a sign of our commitment to God and to spiritual growth.

An Ash Wednesday Prayer

"Ashes to ashes. Dust to dust." You remind us today, oh Lord, of our origin and end.
In the beginning, You fashioned us in the Garden. You dignified dust with the Breath of Life.
You made us in Your image and likeness.

You led Your people through the dust of the Sinai wilderness to the Promised Land.
You overcame temptation in the dry desert. You healed the blind with dirt and clay.

Three times Your body stirred the dust as you fell on the road to Calvary.

Hear the cry of Your people! One day we will return to dust.

This Lenten season, stir our minds to contemplate You, our hearts to love You, and our bodies to serve You in our brothers and sisters.
May our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving be Your breath alive in us.

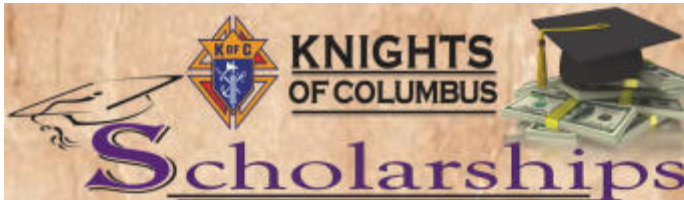
