

#### Pastor's Message



Today is the fourth consecutive solemnity we are celebrating. This weekend is The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ, formerly Corpus Christi. These celebrations are primary feast days that honor our God as Father or Jesus or the Spirit. Today we recognize the gift of the Eucharist that Jesus has left us as a re-


minder of what He has done for us all. This solemnity, or better, it is the solemn commemoration of the institution of that sacrament called the Eucharist. It is, moreover, the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, who by instituting the Holy Eucharist gave to the Church her greatest treasure. Holy Thursday marks the anniversary of the institution, but the commemoration of the Lord's passion that very night suppresses the rejoicing proper to the occasion. Today's observance, therefore, accents the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday. It was none other than St. Thomas Aquinas who edited and/or composed the Mass and the Office – the prayers of the day – for this feast day. This was requested by Pope Urban IV in the year 1264. It is a classic piece of liturgical work, wholly in accord with the best liturgical traditions.

Our three readings for the Liturgy – Genesis, 1 Corinthians and Luke - accent sharing, sacrifice and nurturing with food. Our first reading from Genesis gives us an example of tithing that Abraham initiated with Melchizedek. Our second reading shows the gift of sacrifice that Jesus is willing to do for us. And our gospel accents how we nurture others by the sharing of what gifts we have received. And they, in turn, feed us with their gifts. All of us are invited to build up one another through sharing, sacrifice and nurturing. We are blessed and gifted with the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. It is our Catholic belief that the bread and wine become the Real Presence of Christ in our celebration of faith. When that takes place during the Eucharistic prayer, proclaimed by the celebrant, it is no longer ordinary bread and wine. It has now become the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ! And so we reverently take the gift of Jesus into our hands or on the tongue. We can't earn or even demand this. It is truly the primary gift to all of us from our God. We are being fed by God Himself. A sign that a person wishes to become Catholic and join us in our faith is that yearning that takes place to receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

So as you come forth today – or any day for that matter – do so with the mindset that this gift is extraordinary and it is an example we are to follow – sharing, sacrificing and nurturing – others as we ourselves are receiving.

#### LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

How can we ever succeed at truly loving God and our neighbor and fully embrace Gospel living? Achieving this goal without an intimate connection with Christ is impossible. The Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ, connects us with God in a unique and most intimate way. His very life and presence is wedded with ours. Being forgiven and nourished, we are given the strength and conviction to pick up our wounded and broken lives and be living heralds of Good News. Our world is broken and needs authentic, living witnesses to bring it back to truth. Nourished by the Body and Blood of Christ, are you ready to be sent?

#### **EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP -**RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

When I was a child, I can remember stopping by my parish or another local Catholic church to just spend some time in prayer before the Holy Eucharist. We didn't have exposition and adoration much in those days, but we were keenly aware of the presence of Jesus in the tabernacle. I would sometimes stare at the lighted candle near it and know that Jesus was alive.

I had never heard someone speak about a stewardship way of life back then. If I am honest, the primary message I heard in those days was along the lines of "We need to be as good as we are able." Sacrifice was only at Lent, disciples were people in the Bible, and generosity mostly had to do with the collection basket and the poor box at the church entrance. I even went to Catholic

Maybe the message of stewardship was there somewhere packaged differently, and I just missed it. It wasn't until I was an adult, and after acquiring two theology degrees, that I understood both with my head and my heart what a stewardship way of life really meant. But I look back at those days, and I realize that the groundwork was laid for me to understand these things. It was those times before the Holy Eucharist that I began to understand true sacrifice. It was at those times that I began to understand how actions and realities that seem so simple to the human eye can be so profound. And it was at those times that I began to see true love knows no bounds.

#### WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

#### Question:

How do you explain "Real Presence" to children.

The first Communion class is filled with excitement to the point of bursting! They are just awestruck by every new thing they learn about Jesus. Their enthusiasm is contagious as they rattle off the names of the things in church, the vessels and vestments used at Mass, and the names of their pastors and priests. Of course, they know Christ can do anything because he's God. He comes to us in holy Communion because he loves us so much that he wants to be with us. And he comes to us in the form of bread and wine. We really receive him in the Eucharist.

Sometimes it is easier to explain this to children than to adults. Their faith and trust in Jesus is not limited by the questions and doubts that often come with the question of how he does it. Rather, they focus on the question "why," and the answer is something they can easily grasp: love. Christ wants to be with us because he loves us. Nothing is purer in truth or in faith. Not even the theological explanation of transubstantiation, or philosophical reasoning or symbolic references, come close. Christ takes on the form of bread and wine to be simple and approachable, so that no one is afraid or turned away. His love for us is complete and total. We try to love him the same way in return. For a child, it is simple. For us adults, we keep trying. "Unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven" (Mt 18:3).

before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. The service will last approximately 50 minutes.

#### The Eucharist

On feasts such as this, we recall miracles like the wedding feast at Cana or the multiplication of the loaves. Perhaps we remember the road to Emmaus, when Jesus was made known "in the breaking of the bread." In these stories, God satisfies our hunger in a supernatural way. But the cry of the human heart goes much deeper. "Man cannot live on bread alone," after all. In the Eucharist, God's supernatural presence takes the form of physical food. In the absence of physical nourishment, the body slowly begins to break down. Without an intentional pursuit of spiritual nourishment, our souls will similarly suffer. Our inner lives need rest and rejuvenation. We need daily connection with our Creator. We need to receive from the One who feeds us. The radical reality of the Eucharist speaks to our deeper aches, to the God who alone satisfies.







#### ASK YOURSELF, "WHAT WOULD JESUS DO?"

Central American fathers, mothers, and children, who seek asylum in the US from the violence and poverty they suffer in their countries, are bussed in every day from Dilley and Karnes Detention Centers to catch a bus or a plane in San Antonio, so they can go on their journey to join their relatives who live throughout the U.S. Between 75 and 100 men, women and children arrive every morning and afternoon at both the bus station and the airport. Late afternoon each day, a large number arrive on bus from Laredo. Sister Denise LaRock, Daughter of Charity of St Vincent de Paul, coordinates the volunteers at the bus station under the auspices of the Interfaith Welcome Coalition. The volunteers greet them, help them get their travel tickets and insure they get on their bus or their plane. The majority of the asylum seekers are Spanish speakers.





#### Reflection ~ Freedom

"I can't forgive him, he's not sorry for what he did." was the response from Stacy when she was asked how she felt about forgiving her former spouse. She went on to explain that she thought that, just as in order to receive forgiveness from God for our sins we must be truly sorry, the person we must forgive must be equally sorry to be eligible for forgiveness. Right idea, wrong application. We must be sorry for our sins in order to be forgiven. However, forgiving someone else for their transgression is our decision, not theirs.

When we forgive someone, we benefit from the forgiveness, not the other person. They may never be aware that we have forgiven them. It doesn't matter. Their ultimate forgiveness is between them and God. Forgiving someone is essential to our healing because it is an intentional letting go of all the hurt, anger, and injustice committed by the other person. While we would be justified in holding this person hostage to their transgression, our decision to let it all go is a great act of mercy that sets us free. Letting go of our "right" to retribution, frees us from our own self-induced bondage to the pain from the past. If we don't let go, it saps the life out of us as we drag around this heavy burden. We get stuck in our past by reliving it everyday. And, like a wound that we keep pulling the scab off of, we never heal. The most loving act we can do for ourselves is to forgive those that have hurt us. Only then can we heal and be truly free to live and love.

Then Peter came up and said to Jesus, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven. - Matthew
