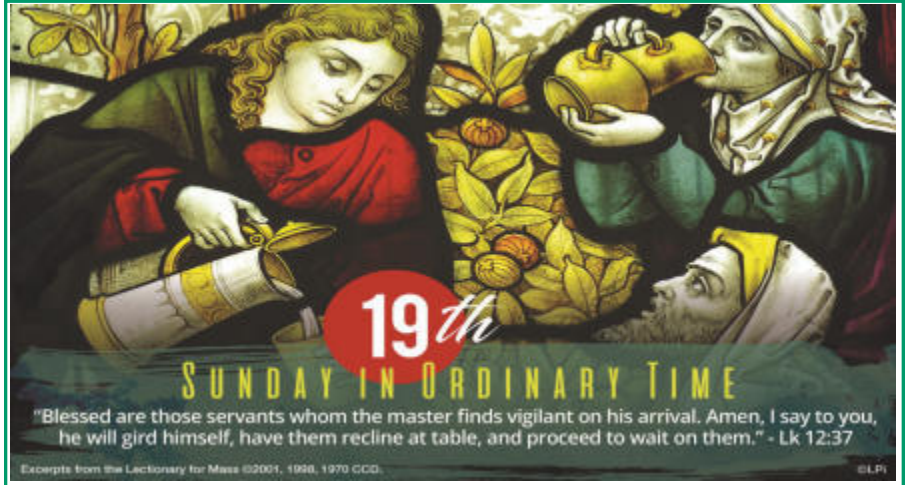

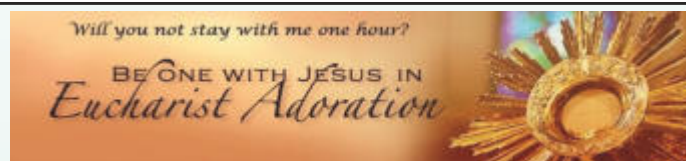

Pastor's Message



Soren Kierkegaard was a great Danish philosopher. He had a favorite story about an emperor. This emperor was touring his domain, receiving the accolades of his people. Eventually, his entourage reached the market square of one of the villages. The emperor's carriage was surrounded by cheering villagers and peasants. But then an amazing thing happened. One brash young farmer stepped out of the crowd, approaching the emperor's carriage. "Give me a boon, sire," he pleaded. "Grant me a special blessing." The villagers were even more amazed at the emperor's reply. "Of course, my good man," the emperor said. "Get into my carriage. Come with me. Live in my palace. Eat at my table. Marry my daughter. Be my son-in-law." The young man exclaimed his delight, "I could be the emperor's son-in-law!" Then he thought about it. No more Saturday nights at the pub with his friends. He could no longer wear dirty, comfortable peasant clothes. He'd have to get dressed up. He'd have to take a bath - maybe every week! He'd have to clean his fingernails. He'd have to learn the manners of the court. He sadly shook his head and lowered his eyes. "No, sire," he said. "I would be too uncomfortable. It would pull me out of my comfortable customs. It would be too hard to live up to. It would take too much of me." And so the young man said to the emperor, "This is what you could do for me, sire." "Give me a plot of ground, a farm, a house of my own. But to live in your palace, eat at your table, be your son-in-law - this is too much." So he declined it. What would have prompted the brash, young man to decline the emperor's offer? Yes, the young man wanted the emperor's blessing. But he wanted it on his own terms. He wanted to be blessed in doing what he wanted to do - not what the emperor wanted. He wanted to be blessed right where he was. He did not want to be moved out of his comfort zone. **He wanted the blessing, but not the responsibility that went with it!** ... What about each of us? What happens when we find ourselves out of our comfort zones? Is their frustration? Is their anger? Is there an unwillingness to move? Is there fear? Remember the opening words of today's gospel? Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom. Jesus reminds us that there is no need to fear. But fear is a very powerful emotion that at times can overwhelm us. But with trust and faith in God, fear no longer paralyzes us.

HOLYDAY OF OBLIGATION



Our next Holyday of Obligation is August 15 with the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In the United States, we have now five (5) Holydays of this nature. Some years back, the TX Roman Catholic bishops transferred the Ascension to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Two of the Holydays – The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (December 8) and The Nativity of the Lord (Christmas) (December 25) are ALWAYS Holydays of Obligations. The other two – Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (January 1) and All Saints (November 1) are Holydays of Obligation UNLESS they fall on a Saturday or a Monday. The obligation is abrogated on those days. This year, 2019, is unique in that December 8 falls on a Sunday. It conflicts with the Second Sunday of Advent. Priority is given to the Advent season. The feast day is transferred to Monday, December 9, but the obligation is not. Hope is that this explanation clarifies and not further confuses the people of Holy Trinity!

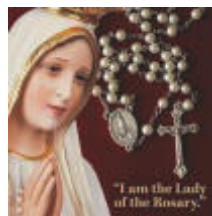
Holy Trinity Prayer Shawl Ministry

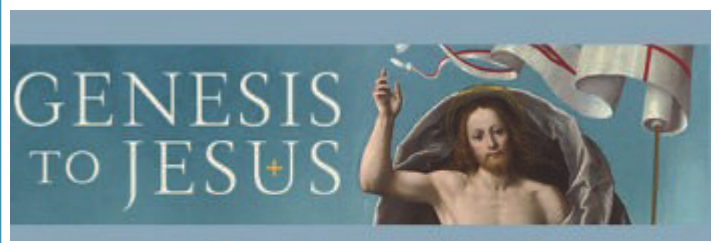

Reflection ~ True Love

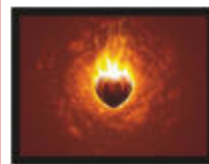
