

Pastor's Message



The prophet Isaiah reminds the people that if they learn to care for one another they will be able to receive God's care. Their rituals, their activities, their behavior – all must express a genuine conversion of their hearts. Their actions must be genuine and not half-

hearted attempts at compliance with God's directive to care for one another. One cannot expect to twist God's arm with feeble attempts to respond with little to no effort and conviction. Isaiah points out concrete examples and solid behavior: share your bread with the hungry; shelter the oppressed and homeless; clothe the naked; do not turn your back on your own. He goes on further with behaviors of the person who cares for another: remove oppression, false accusation and malicious speech. When you do, the darkness gives way to the light that is seen in and through you. Jesus echoes these encouragements from Isaiah in today's gospel. He likewise calls His followers to conduct their lives so that they will call attention to the presence of God within them. Jesus uses the symbols of salt, light and a city on a hill to offer a clear way that He shows what this message means. Salt enhances the flavor of foods. Light helps us overcome any potential stumbling blocks we might encounter. Being like a city on a hill indicates a person who is authentic, real and someone that "what you see is what you get" imagery. How does your life fit these images?

WHY DO WE DO THAT? CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish

FINANCE COUNCIL MEETING The following are highlights from the FC meeting held on January 29, 2020.

- Opening Prayer: Lunch preceded meeting; prayer opened meeting.
- Review of December 31, 2019 Statement: The FC reviewed the quarterly financial statements to this date.
- <u>Archbishop's Appeal 2019:</u> The assessment for Holy Trinity for 2019 was \$214,426. The pledges totaled \$151,265 while the cash collected was \$150,006. Remember: The assessed amount is a mathematical one based on income from previous years of each parish.
- Capital Campaign Update:

Amount Pledged \$2,926,393.82 from 906 families

Amount Paid to Date per PDS \$1,972,641.96
Balance Due \$ 953,751.86

Amount due to Archdiocese beginning July 2019 is \$2,166,300. Monthly amount is \$60,175 for a three-year period.

- New Federal Law: This law went into effect January 1st and affects hourly wages. This new law addressed the salary of five (5) of our full time employees. Salary adjustments were made to these five to address the new law.
- <u>Potential New FC Members:</u> Msgr. Mike was offered three (3) additional names to add to the membership of the Finance Council. He will contact all of them to see what their interest might be to join the FC.
- <u>Future Celebrations:</u>
 - 1. 40th Anniversary and Retirement Celebration for Msgr. Mike, Sunday, April 19, to include a bi-lingual Mass at 11:30, combining the 11:15 and 1PM Masses that Sunday. Celebration continues after the Mass in the Banquet Hall.
 - 2. Ministry Appreciation Dinner is Wednesday, May 6th, 7PM, Banquet Hall.
 - 3. Despedida for Fr. Daniel, Sunday, June 21st, 3PM, Banquet Hall50th Anniversary of Ordination Mass at 11:15AM
 - 4. June 28th, followed with a gathering in the Banquet Hall to honor the founding pastor of Holy Trinity.
- Closing Prayer: Meeting ended with a prayer.
- Next Meeting: Wednesday, May 6th, 12:30pm in Conference Room. (This meeting is to include quarterly financial statement review and a presentation of Budget for FY2020-2021)


The Catholic Daughters of the Americas will support literacy for children served by the DePaul Children's Center of Ascension DePaul Services of San Antonio.







I remember how anxious and worried I would be over each new crisis that erupted during my divorce. After the storm passed, I would feel relieved. One day in Mass, the Gospel reading was about Mary and Martha. It didn't seem fair. Martha asked Jesus to talk to her sister and tell her to get up and help. Jesus's response to Martha hit me like a ton of bricks. He told her not to worry or be anxious and instead to follow her sister's example. Mary had chosen to focus on Christ. There was my solution to overcoming my anxiety and worry. I needed to focus more on Jesus and trust in Him. He promises by doing that, everything else will fall into place. So, there you have it. When you are anxious and worried, sit at Jesus's feet in Mass, adoration, reading scripture, and in prayer. He is the only thing you need to deal with life's challenges and hardships.

21 Day Marriage Press Gentle Physical Touch & Blessings

This month we are focusing on the details of the 21 Day Marriage Press to help us jump start the year with an infusion of love in our marriage. The 21 Day Marriage Press has 7 things we do each day to pump up our marriage. Today, let's talk about the last of the 7 daily items, Gentle Physical Touch and Recording Your Blessings...

Gentle Physical Touch

Gentle physical touch is holding hands, a kiss on the cheek or forehead, sitting close on the couch; anything that is not aggressive or implies you want "more". It is important to establish trust with your spouse that touching doesn't always have to be about sex

Record Your Blessings (in a small notebook)

- This is probably the most challenging yet one of the most important of the 7 items.
- Buy a small notebook and begin recording your blessings every day.
- Try to identify at least 3 Blessings that are related to your marriage.
- o If you are in crisis, it might be challenging to find even 1 blessing related to your marriage. Partly because there is very little going on you would consider a blessing and partly because we have stopped looking for the blessings because the negative has overwhelmed us. I promise there is at least one blessing in your marriage each day; you might have to look very hard for it or you might need to lower the bar a little BUT once you start praying for your marriage and your spouse, God will be faithful with the blessings, they just might not be what you were hoping for.
- Why record our blessings? It is so very easy to focus on what isn't going well or what has hurt us. Even if our marriage is not in crisis, the busyness of life can often get in the way and keep us from seeing and appreciating the good that is happening. Focusing on our blessings each day helps us focus on the good that is happening and over time we can look back and see how much God has really blessed us.
