From Our Parish Evangelist,

This week, the Church throughout the world will celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. While it is distinguished as a holy day of obligation for the faithful, it does not carry the 'fanfare' of solemnities such as Easter, Christmas, or even Ash Wednesday! Yet the Church has been solemnly remembering this event since the earliest centuries, and the implications of the event we commemorate is as profound as any other.

The Catechism teaches us: Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence he will come again (cf. Acts 1:11); this humanity in the meantime hides him from the eyes of men (cf. Col 3:3). Jesus Christ, the head of the Church, precedes us into the Father's glorious kingdom so that we, the members of his Body, may live in the hope of one day being with him for ever. Jesus Christ, having entered the sanctuary of heaven once and for all, intercedes constantly for us as the mediator who assures us of the permanent outpouring of the Holy Spirit. (CCC 665-667).

It is an interesting meditation to ask ourselves, "Is heaven a place? Or is it some state of being or consciousness?" The historical reality of the Ascension gives us the answer: Heaven is indeed a real place, because there is a body there! Matter requires a space to occupy, so our Resurrected Lord ascended body and soul into heaven - a physical reality through logical necessity.

It is said that by His death and Resurrection, Jesus opened the gates of heaven for all humanity. This is true, and His Ascension demonstrates this to us. It is His proof that those of us who believe in Him in faith and follow Him will also be raised on the last day, and enter into heaven.

From heaven, Jesus hears our prayers and intercedes for us with His Father. As we celebrate the Ascension together as a family, let us look with hope to the day when we will indeed join Him, body and soul. He has indeed prepared a place for us.
