From Our Pastor,

Brothers and Sisters-

St Columban wrote, “Those who want to understand the unfathomable depths of God must first consider the world of nature; Knowledge of the Trinity is rightly compared with the depths of the sea.” This mystery of the Trinity is deep and beautiful; beyond our human knowledge and comprehension...

WE, as human beings, however, know more about this great mystery than we think through our human experience. In our very nature, we imitate this mystery of the life of the Trinity, in a very REAL WAY each and every day.

This Gospel points to the fact that the mystery of the Trinity is ALL ABOUT RELATIONSHIP. There is this mystical bond and mutual exchange of infinite love between these Three Divine Persons.

The Father gives of him self completely to the son in total self-gift...everything...with the one exception that he is the Father. In return, the Son (Jesus Christ), gives Himself completely to the Father, with the one exception of his identity as the Son. This overflowing bond of love is then poured out and given to all of us in the Holy Spirit, by which grace is poured into each of our lives.

But the persons of the Trinity are not independent of themselves...they always NEED to be in relationship with the other. Our God IS these 3 persons IN RELATIONSHIP! The Father is only the Father because of the Son. There is an interdependency in this beautiful and mysterious relationship; a relationship of 'Total Gift of self' to the other!!

So if this divine personhood of God is only found through RELATIONSHIP, then true HUMAN personhood is only found through relationship!!

Cardinal Walter Kasper states, “the mystery of the Trinity reveals the true meaning of OUR being.....What it means to EXIST is found in the selflessness of love!!”

Therefore, our own lives are Trinitarian by their very nature. Not only were we created in the image and likeness of God, but we are each called to be that TOTAL self gift for others. To do this, we need to be in relationship with others, giving of ourselves completely. In this way we can be fully HUMAN, and fully a person!


