From Our Parish Evangelist,

Greetings from Camp Fatima! It's been a blessed start to the summer here in Gilmanton on the shores of Upper Suncook Lake. The sun is hot, the trees are shady, and the lake refreshes body and soul. A couple hundred boys and young men are enjoying swimming, sailing, paddling, horseback riding, archery, riflery, bonfires, sports, and everything in-between - even celebrating Mass together twice a week! I am truly blessed to be a part of it - it has really brought out the kid in me already.

Speaking of kids - True North VBS at St. Mark's was amazing! A heap of gratitude to Amanda Morgan on behalf of our entire church family for orchestrating such an awesome week for our youth. Personally, there are few things that lift my soul as much as hearing the laughter and delight of children here at St. Mark's. They are truly the future of our parish, our diocese, and our whole Catholic Church!

This Sunday we celebrate the solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. How appropriate it is to celebrate our youth at the same time... The characters of Peter and Paul are exemplars of human formation. Peter - a simple working man who fumbled with his faith and identity only to emerge as Christ's vicar here on earth to the end of the ages. Paul - a cynical opportunist who encountered the Truth and goes on to lead the conversion of civilizations.

We have numerous Peters and Pauls right here among us! Young men and women whose souls and intellects are malleable. Who will form them? The world? The culture? "Influencers"? Perhaps on many levels it is unavoidable - just as Peter and Paul were products of their circumstances and experiences. What was the turning point? When did the desire for virtue and truth take hold of them and begin to form them into saints? When they encountered the living God, the source of all goodness, the manifestation of Truth itself - Jesus Christ.

That's where you and I come in. There is no lack of opportunity for anyone to hear the Gospels and learn the Catechism - the vast deposit of human knowledge is just a few short keyboard strokes away. We can tell our young people about Christ until we are blue in the face - but if we don't *show* them Christ, why do we expect them to embrace His teachings? One of the things that has amazed me most about working with young people is how well they can detect a lack of authenticity. They don't really care what you *say* - they truly notice what you *do*.

Brother and sisters, by virtue of our baptism we are Christ's Mystical Body. Peter and Paul experienced the grace of encountering Jesus Christ face-to-face, so to speak. Our young men and women have the same opportunity, yet the face of Christ they encounter will be your face and mine. Let us keep this blessed opportunity and responsibility in mind as we continue our mission to form our youth with the joy of the Gospel and a life of discipleship.

Don't just tell them - show them.

Grace Within - SAVE THE DATE

The Women's Ministry is offering an eight-week program, Grace Within, on Wednesday evenings at 7PM from September 24 - November 12. Registration begins on July 20. Participation is limited to 12 women. The cost is \$20. An Introductory Gathering (distribution of books) is scheduled for Wednesday, September 17 at 7PM. Weekly topics including Self-Esteem and Self-Acceptance, Stress, Worries and Anxiety, Everyday Spirituality, and Expressing Value in Friendship are designed to help you understand how you can grow spiritually, and become who God created you to be. For maximum benefit a commitment to weekly attendance is optimal. The program is based on the Benedictine values of Prayer, Hospitality, Reflection, Listening and Community and is structured so that you can acknowledge and better understand your sacredness, your God-given spiritual gifts, and the call to share those gifts in community and ministry. The last week (November 12) is a Celebration of New Beginnings with dinner, music, a guest speaker, and recognition of individual charism. 
