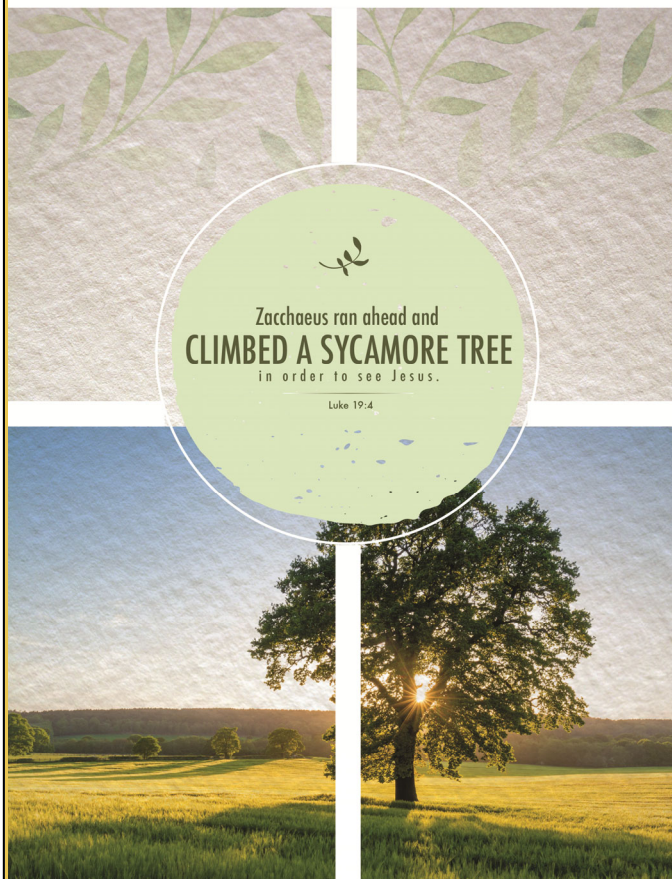

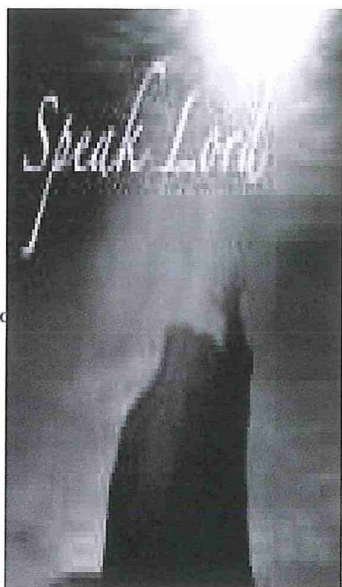

Are You Using God's gifts to do God's Works?

Together We Can Build the Kingdom

Every week during Mass the presider prays, "Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God." We respond, "It is right and just." Do we really mean what we are saying? Catholics profess to believe that God is the Master who owns everything and generously allows us, the stewards, to use certain things during our life's journey. In practice, however, we can get "hung up" on the concept of God as the owner of all things. Some might respond, "After all, don't we work hard to provide for our families?" Here we must recognize that the very talents and abilities we use to make a living - including life itself - are also God's gifts!

As we strive together to insure the fiscal health of our parish, it is important to remember that every one of us is called to respond in proportion to our ability. One pastor used a striking visual to demonstrate the power of community action. On Sunday the ushers handed each person coming into church a small handful of pebbles to put in the basket that was in the middle of the main isle. When it was time for the homily to begin, the pastor asked the gift bearers to bring the basket of pebbles forward and they could barely lift it. The pastor's message was that even the smallest action, the most seemingly insignificant gift, can have great power when it is combined with the gifts of others.

We have all been blessed and *We Are Called* to steward our blessings faithfully. It's not about guilt. It's about responding from a spirit of thanksgiving and joy. All we need to do is remember something else we hear at mass every week, ... "Christ our Lord, through whom You bestow on the world all that is good."

This week: Think about a time when you experience the pure joy of giving from the heart. Pray for the grace to see that, combining the gifts of many, we can make great things happen as we work together to build God's Kingdom here on earth.

There is one more thing you must do. Go and sell what you have and give to the poor; you will then have treasure in heaven.

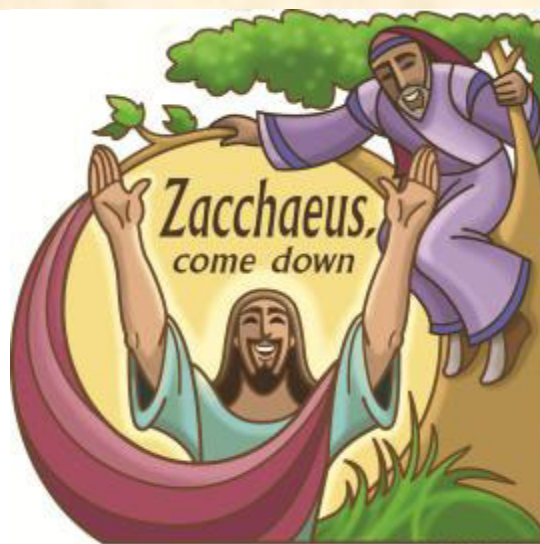

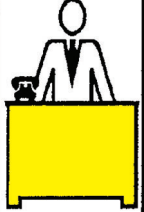
