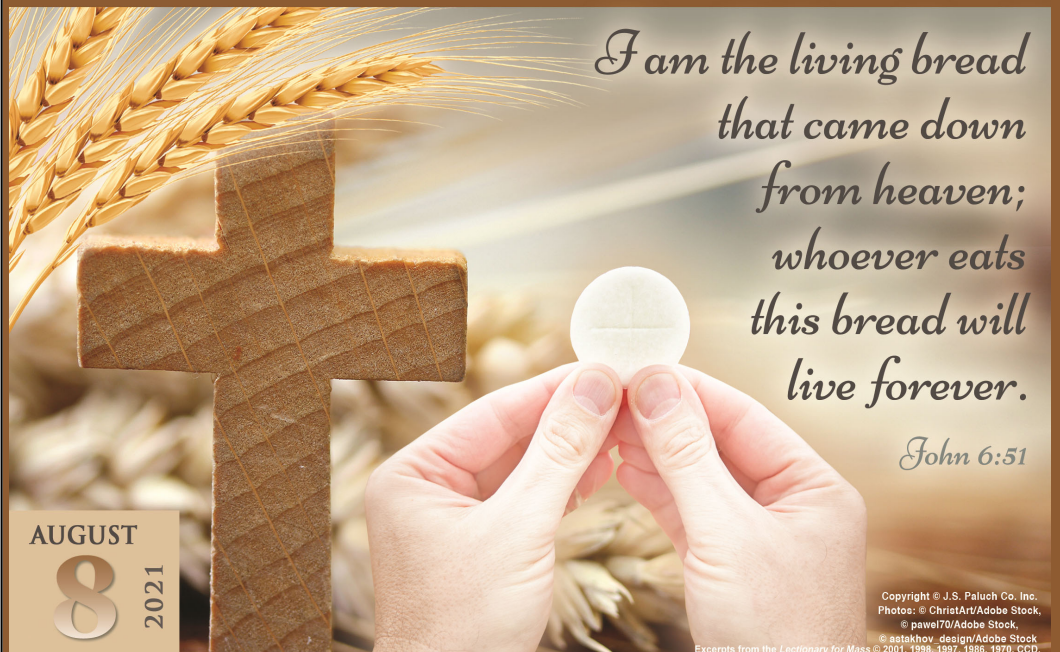

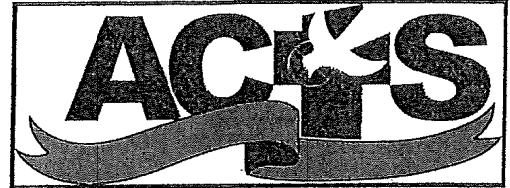

New Iberia Women's ACTS Retreat

Retreat Information

Women of New Iberia Catholic Churches - You are invited to experience a weekend retreat that will strengthen your faith, renew your spirituality, and build a stronger community within your churches, all through and with Jesus Christ.

ACTS is an acronym for Adoration, Community, Theology & Service. The ACTS Weekend is presented by a team of local Catholic women with support provided by Father Keith Landry as Spiritual Director, and by the Pastors of the participating New Iberia catholic churches. ACTS is a Parish-based retreat and ministry.

The retreat begins Thursday evening, Oct 21, 2021, with check-in at 5:30 pm at the Sacred Heart Church Hall, 2514 Old Jeanerette Rd, New Iberia, LA. Transportation is provided to and from **Stillwater Retreat Center** in Abbeville. We will return to Sacred Heart Church on Sunday, Oct 24, for the 10:30 am Mass.

Space on the retreat is limited and the participants selected are based on the order in which the registrations are received. Registration is open to those women who attend the following Iberia Parish churches: Nativity of Our Lady, St Peter's, St Edward's, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, and Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The cost of the retreat is \$295. A deposit of \$50 is required at the time of registration, with full payment due on Thursday during Check-in. Please note that Financial difficulties should NOT prevent anyone from attending the retreat. If you have financial concerns, confidential arrangements can be made by contacting the Retreat Director listed below.

When your registration is accepted, our team will contact you to confirm your attendance. About 2-3 weeks prior to the retreat, we will send you details describing the items that you should bring on Retreat.

Registration & Payments: Checks are made payable to St. Mary Magdalen Church, who serves as the Mission Church for the Retreat. You may submit your check along with your paper application to the Nativity of Our Lady church office.
