## Message from the Pastor

Now we get to the real work in our parishes...

We have finished the bulk of the renovation project at Holy Rosary and we have St. Patrick's spruced up quite a bit (with the big window restoration project to happen shortly). So, now we get going on what is most important – living our Catholic lives more fully and getting the word out to all around us that we have something very special at our parishes.

We especially want to make an effort at inviting and encouraging those we know who have not been to church in a while or seldom go. We have a perfect opportunity. Just ask them, "Have you seen the new Holy Rosary church recently?" or "Have you been to St. Patrick's church in a while?" Maybe we could phrase it like this, "You aren't going to believe what Holy Rosary Church looks like these days, would you like to come to Mass with me Saturday night?"

Maybe they haven't been to church since I've been pastor. Together we have made a lot of changes to Holy Rosary and to St. Patrick's. And there is an excitement in the air at both parishes. I'm realizing that there are so many Catholics right here in St. Marys who no longer practice, or practice very little, the faith of their baptism. I know there are circumstances, experiences and life-situations which may prevent them from going regularly to Mass. I also know that many have either fallen asleep in the faith life or are running from God.

What peace a life lived in the Catholic Church can give. What a sense of security and togetherness it can bring. We have that here at our parishes. Now it's a matter of getting the word out and invite and encourage others. So, let's get to work!
