#### Message from the Pastor

Corpus Christi custodiat me in vitam aeternam.

These are the words the priest says quietly before receiving Holy Communion at Mass: May the Body of Christ keep me safe for eternal life. Receiving the Eucharist in Holy Communion at Mass is our surest way to eternal life in Heaven and we ask our Lord to keep us safe on our way there.

As we celebrate the Real Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist today, Corpus Christi Sunday, we should be making that prayer all the stronger. Lord, keep me safe for eternal life. Don't let me be damaged by sin. Don't let the world seep into my heart and corrupt the goodness you have sown in me. Keep me from falling into sin. Keep me safe from the attacks of the devil. It comes down to our faith and hope in an eternal life united to Christ. If we realize that is our best destiny and the greatest happiness we will ever know, which, by the way, will last forever, then we will rush to Holy Communion each week to get a taste of what is to come. If you want an eternity with Christ in Heaven, you will want to be with him here on earth. He gives us the chance in Holy Communion. Let's prepare ourselves and receive him well.

## AGAPE SUMMER BREAKFAST/LUNCH PROGRAM

Agape will be offering their Summer Feeding Program bags again this year. It is hard to believe that this will be our twelfth year. Since we provide these bags to all the students who were enrolled in their respective schools free and reduced breakfast and/or lunch programs, we potentially could offer these bags to 1057 students each month. While this is a staggering number of students who are enrolled, we provide for an average of 910 to 965 bags each month.

Each student will receive a total of 41 shelf stable items, 6 cold and frozen items and 5 soft and squishy items. These are packed into a total of 3 bags. The shelf stable items can be pre-packed but the cold and frozen and the soft and squishy must to be packed as needed.

This requires a substantial amount of work. This is why we require volunteer groups to assist in these packing parties. If you have adults and children that have time during the day, evenings or Saturdays, please let us know so we can make arrangements to have them pack bags for us. Only an hour or so is needed and we can accommodate anywhere from 5 to 35 or so at a time.
