Both of these images reveal the essence of what Heaven will be like. How? To get a glimpse of what it will be like in Heaven we look at what we do each week in church when we celebrate Mass. Each week we are gathered around the table of God (the altar) and we sing hymns before the throne (the Cross) and play music (the organ or piano are the harps) and we have a feast (the Eucharistic Bread and Wine). 
