Charitable Giving Plan for IRA's

Are you frustrated by the Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) rule for your IRA? If you are like most people receiving annual income from IRA, you are likely paying more in taxes each year. The good news is that rolling over all or a part of your RMD to a charity like Holy Rosary School, Holy Rosary Church or Friends of Holy Rosary, can help reduce your tax bill while supporting the ministry of Holy Rosary Church or School.

When you reach the age of 70 ½ years, the government requires you to take a Required Minimum Distribution each year. Congress has passed a law that gives you another option. Although there are different situations for different people, many of us can use the "IRA Charitable Rollover" to donate up to \$100,000 per year to your favorite qualified charity. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows you to directly transfer a RMD from your IRA without counting it as income thus reducing taxes. This option will allow you to maximize your gifts to Holy Rosary or Friends of Holy Rosary.

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Have you heard of "7 Sensational Dates", a marriage renewal program offered in January and sponsored by Holy Rosary? The program is designed to help married couples learn practical tools to build strong and healthy marriages. While enjoying a catered dinner from local restaurants at a candlelit table for two, couples watch a DVD and have a chance to discuss important issues often ignored in the rush of daily life. There is no group discussion or group sharing; it's all one-on-one, husband and wife. I know that sounds scary, but it is just what many couples need. The program begins Friday, January 11th, and continues each Friday through February 22nd. It only costs \$92 per couple, which is only \$13 per night out – a very cheap date, guys. This will be the second time we've done this program. This first time was referred to as "fantastic" by the couples who participated.

Your marriage is one of the most important parts of your life, right up there with your faith and life in the Church, and your children. Do you want to have a successful marriage? Do you want to have peace in your home? You know it's not automatic; not easy either. It takes effort and a little extra work. It's strange to me when I see couples not really putting the effort into making a successful marriage. Not just divorce, but also hurts and misunderstandings, arguments and fights, are a sad part of many couples' lives these days. If you don't think you need a program like "7 Sensational Dates", you probably do. If you think your marriage is going fine, why not kick it up to the next level through this program. Hey, married couples, challenge yourself. Go for success in your married life. Happiness will come with it if you do.

In all this, I think the most important thing couples need today is a deeper, more active living of the Catholic Faith. Couples who go to church together will stay together. Couples that pray together hardly ever face a situation of divorce. If you want to have a successful marriage, pray and go to church together. I'm telling you, there is no better way to go. I hope you will consider enrolling in the "7 Sensational Dates" program. And I really hope you will practice your Catholic Faith with greater vigor and devotion.


