### MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

On Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, Ambrose Dobroszi became Father Ambrose when Archbishop Dennis Schnurr laid his hands on his head and pronounced the words of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. Father Ambrose was changed for all eternity. He is a priest forever, another Christ, ordained to serve the Church and the People of God.

We should all be very proud of our parish son, our seminarian intern, who spent a year with us to learn what it meant to be a parish priest. I think you share my joy that we collaborated with God in forming a man He had called to be a priest. His year here at Holy Rosary/St. Patrick was a great learning experience for him and I think it launched him down the road in his vocation. So, thank you to all who prayed for Fr. Ambrose and who helped guide him in his vocation. Job well done!

Being at the ordination Mass on Saturday brought back many fond memories of my ordination day. I was ordained on May 23, 2009. This year was my tenth anniversary of ordination. It has flown by so quickly. I feel like I'm just getting started. I want to thank all of you who have been such good parishioners and friends to me in my priestly service.

My ordination day was very special because my dad was able to be there. I had been praying for him to witness me becoming a priest for some time. It was put to the test when he was diagnosed with cancer three years before my ordination date. He went through the chemo and the radiation and surgery for me. And I was so happy when he entered the cathedral, tears in his eyes. He said he hadn't been able to cry since the diagnosis three years earlier, and that once he set foot in the cathedral, was not able to stop.

That next day I celebrated my first Mass at Guardian Angels Parish in Cincinnati. He was there. He said it was the best Mass he had ever attended in his whole life. When I raised the Host and saw him out of the corner of my eye, I looked back at Jesus and with the most profound faith I had ever had, said to Him, "Thank You". My prayer was answered. My faith was made strong. So, I hope to go another ten years at least. Thank you all and God bless you!
