Message from the Pastor

This week is our last week before the Holy Rosary Parish Festival. At the time this is published, we've sold about 650 tickets. I want to thank everybody—Holy Rosary and St. Patrick parishioners, visitors to our parishes, as well as just people in the general public—for supporting this reverse raffle. It goes to a great cause (our parish and especially our school) and my biggest hope for the festival this year is that it will be a great occasion for us to just come together as a parish family and enjoy each other's company. And win big. I really want to win big!

Selling reverse raffle tickets was never on my radar as a "fulfilling venture" when I was studying for the priesthood. But I have to say that in addition to being grateful for people's support, I've been really hopeful for our future as we've sold these tickets. Things like this seem normal in a way, but the more I think about it, the more I realize that people's support for the reverse raffle represents something deeper: it shows how invested people are in our parishes. It shows that by everybody doing just a little bit, we can effect great change in our community.

Sometimes, I forget that. I can look at all the problems in the world and feel overwhelmed. The world is crazy. But then I see people excited to support their parish in a little way like this and I realize, if we can get together and make a parish festival happen, if we can raise all this money for our school, then we can get through the craziness of the world together. It's a foretaste of what a parish could be if we all committed to doing just a little bit. And that's a beautiful thing!

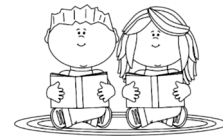
