But then I see people excited to support their parish in a little way like this and I realize, if we can get together and make a parish festival happen, if we can raise all this money for our school, then we can get through the craziness of the world together. It's a foretaste of what a parish could be if we all committed to doing just a little bit. And that's a beautiful thing!


We will meet most Wednesday nights from September through April for 45 minute classes followed by Q and A and small group discussions.


