A declaration of nullity is a formal decision by a Catholic Church Tribunal that a civilly legal marriage between a man and a woman lacked something essential from the moment of consent which prevented this from being a union binding for life according to Catholic Church law.

As of September 14, 2015, there are <u>no fees</u> for marriage cases (Annulments) in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.
