
# Fourth Sunday of Lent ~ March 19, 2023

# Holy Thursday Pilgrimage - April 6

Holy Rosary Church will be one of the "stops" for Adoration on the Holy Thursday night pilgrimage to 7 area churches. After the Mass of the Lord's Supper, seven area churches will place the Eucharist on the Altar of repose for adoration until midnight. All are welcome to make a self-led pilgrimage to each church for adoration. The seven churches correspond with the seven "stops" that Jesus made on His way to Calvary. This tradition is typically credited to St. Philip Neri. There is something powerful about making a late night pilgrimage to our Eucharistic Lord. Dear Parishioner,

Have you contributed your \$5 annual dues for the Friends of Holy Rosary for 2023?

Your dues are used to operate the Friends of Holy Rosary and are separate from the trust. No monies donated to the trust may be used for operating expenses or spent. Annually, unused membership contributions are transferred to the trust fund. Membership is open to ALL, age 18 or older, by paying the \$5 annual dues.

Please drop off your \$5 dues, per individual, using the pink envelope or an envelope marked Friends of Holy Rosary with your name. You can drop in the collection basket or return to the parish office.

At the end of the fiscal year in February, the Board of Trustees of the Friends of Holy Rosary directs that the monies earned the prior year are presented to the parish for designated use for tuition assistance. This past year, the Friends of Holy Rosary presented a check for \$4,599.35. The trust's balance stands at \$309,305.32.
