Each church corresponds with one of the seven “stops” made by Jesus on His way to Calvary (*listed below*).

THE TRADITION

After Mass on Holy Thursday, the Blessed Sacrament is placed on an altar of repose for adoration by the faithful. The tradition of visiting seven churches is typically credited to St. Philip Neri. The faithful are encouraged to visit seven parishes and adore the Lord in the Eucharist. There is something powerful about making a late night pilgrimage to our Eucharistic Lord.

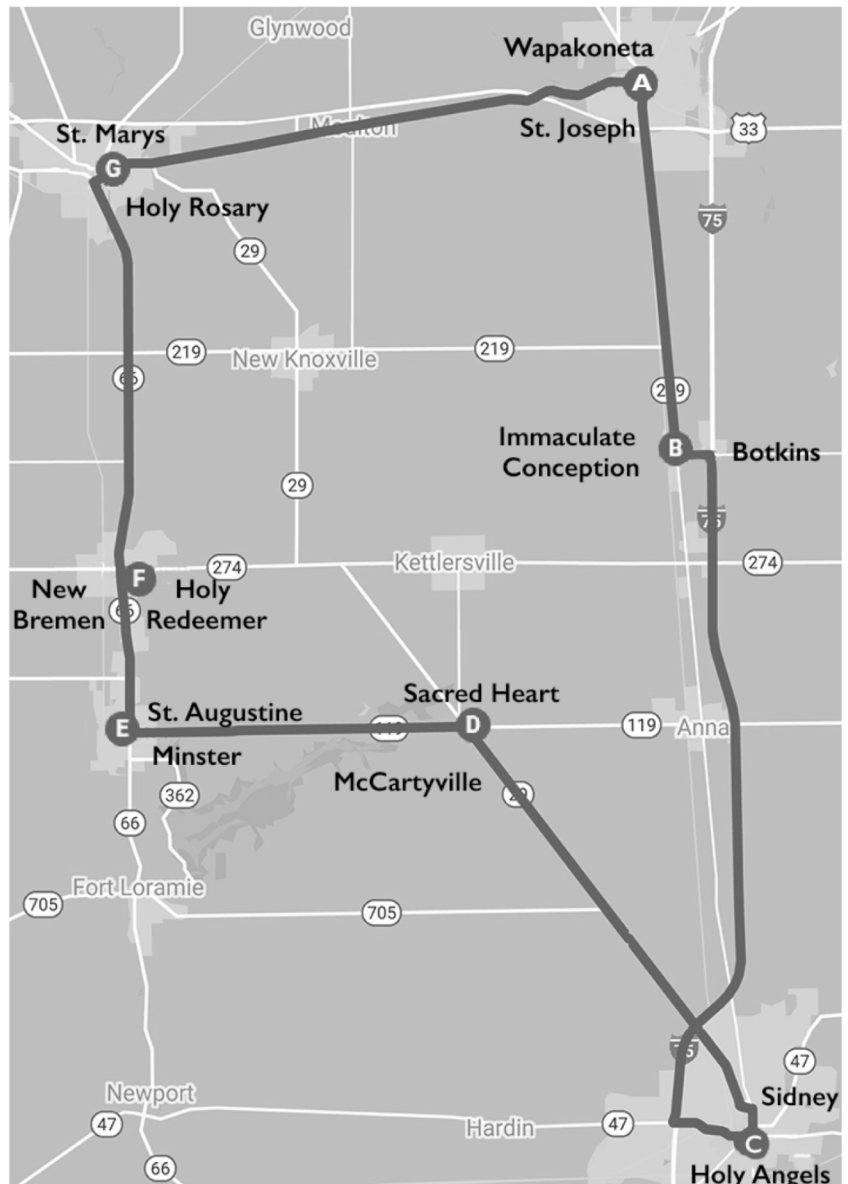
