### 1. Prayer: Fr John

### 2. Introductions:

- O Erik Bonilla- Director of Communication – Erik explained that The St Isidore the Farmer, Family of Parishes Facebook is up and active, the Family Bulletin is planned to be started by Christmas.
- Kelly Schmitmeyer- Director of Worship – Kelly has started meeting with all the musicians in each parish in the family to start learning and meeting these key individuals involved in Liturgy.

Both are excited to meet everyone in the Family and are so excited to be here!

**Tom Pedtke – Beacon's Liaison – Tom joined to update all on the Beacons of Light process and share next steps.**

### 3. Representation of St Isidore the Farmer at the individual Churches.

**What has been discussed in each Parish?**

#### **Holy Rosary**

**Are there any guidelines to share when looking into this? Ultimately the final decision will be Father John's**

**What is the time Frame to complete? St Isidore the Farmer will become the Parish name July 1<sup>st</sup> 2027.**

**This will need to be completed at least by then.**

**Is there a budget to be mindful of? What the parish feels is appropriate.**

**Looking at different locations within the gathering space. Father wanted them to think about the Sanctuary possibly a matching type statue or mosaic, or possibly a picture. The group will discuss further with parishioners of HR.**

#### **St Patrick**

**Talking about adding a statue at the sign, changing sign or statue in the garden.**

**Fr John mentioned possible option is to change the Sacred Heart Statue to a St Isidore Statue?**

#### **Our Lady of Guadalupe**

**The question was asked is this name set in stone. Yes, we chose the name in a way to ensure it does not change when we form 1 canonical parish.**

**Replace banners with a statue could be an option.**

#### **Immaculate Conception**

**Is there a standard for statues whether indoor or outdoor? No it needs to fit the environment.**

**Possibly place a statue or picture where the votive lights are.**

**Father mentioned to find the pedestals from previous statues that were in the sanctuary with St. Gaspar del Bufalo and St. Francis of Assisi and return them to the sanctuary with St Isidore and Gaspar del Bufalo.**

**Place a statue next to the large sign by the side walk. And update the sign.**

#### **St Teresa**

Can 5 like statues be purchased to keep consistency? Each parish has their own feel and environment. They need to find what fits.

Replace one of the St Teresa statues with St Isidore.

This may need to be incorporated with the remodel of the sanctuary.

Statue outside by the back entrance where everyone drives by. Closest to the fields.

Next Steps: Bring Father 3 options and cost of each, by September 1, 2023.

- 4. Stewardship Committee Nominations - During the informational meeting on April 25<sup>th</sup> everyone was invited to the Stewardship retreat for May 20<sup>th</sup>. We have had 3 individuals who have discerned and are wanting to be a part of the Stewardship Retreat. Waiting for a few other responses.**

**There is a need to find members willing to serve on the Family Stewardship Commission by “starting over” with the explanation of what Stewardship truly means. We need to keep in mind Celina is ahead of the rest but will be an asset to catch everyone else up to where they are and continue to move forward with the entire family. This will take time.**

**Tom Pedtke mentioned the training that will be available and it is not a lifelong commitment.**

**The question of getting the youth involved, by having a ministry leader talk to the classes that are of age to help with certain ministries.**

**Fr John reiterated this is more than just volunteers but a way of life. “Everything we have is a gift from God, we are expected to share and use our gifts for others.”**

**5. Weekday Mass Schedules**

**Father asked if everyone would give their thoughts on having all morning weekday Masses starting at 8:00 am? Good Feedback was given. Discussed those who may go to work after? Those coming from other Parishes? And how a schedule would help the Priest.**

**Can Monday morning be moved to OLG? To have 3 weekday Masses at each of the three larger Churches. Comments were that the Monday Mass is the fullest morning Mass at IC.**

**Fr Rob is to ask at Monday’s Mass how the ones in attendance feel about the 8:00 AM start time.**

**What can be done to draw more people to Wednesday night Mass at St Teresa? And possibly during the summer at OLG?**

**Should the Wednesday evening Masses be changed to allow for the priests to visit the CCD programs that are held on Wednesdays?**

**When there are needs for special reconciliation, we are not able to offer this to the CCD students due to the two Masses in the family already. Fr John is hesitant to cancel or change schedule Masses since there are more individuals traveling to other churches in the parish family and also those from outside our family.**

**Could Wednesday Masses start at 5:30 pm to allow for the priests to have time to visit CCD programs?**

**Father John will ask those in attendance at St Teresa their opinion on the time change?**

If the feedback is good, the plan is to start new times on July 1, 2023.



## **6. Beacons**

How do we get the information to the people? Sign up for the Pathway! All parishioners are able.  
Add a Beacons section in the bulletins. Consistent messaging is very important.

Beacons Report in July (Tom)

Tom covered the Pathway and his document. Tom feels that we are doing well in the Beacons process and are ready for Phase 2.

Reminded everyone that a Family Pastoral Council and the Family Leadership Team need to be a huge part of visioning for the family and to be focused on bringing the parishes together.

Also focused on the 3 H's Hymns, Homily, and Hospitality. Things need for the Family to come together and to bring back the Catholics who have left.

He mentioned the Divine Renovation book and that he has asked for a few copies for the Pastoral Council to share.

## **6. Credit Card - OLG**

**Father mentioned that the credit card for OLG needed to be changed to his name. The card will remain with a \$2500 limit.**

**The approval was motioned by Ron Schulze 2<sup>nd</sup> by Karen Smith.**

**All 3 members of OLG on the council approved and signed off.**

*Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's feast marks the beginning of the parish phase and second year of the National Eucharistic Revival. At the same time, we near the end of the first year of Beacons of Light, our archdiocesan planning process. These two initiatives are bound together: our pastoral planning efforts are directed toward building vibrant Eucharistic communities in which we recall all that Christ has done for us and respond as He commands – to eat and drink of His Body and Blood and thus have eternal life.

Eucharist is the first principle of Beacons of Light: “The Mass is the source and summit of the whole Christian life. Accordingly, the Eucharist is the essential moment for building up and strengthening the parish community, along with the sacraments and other celebrations of the paschal mystery – the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.”

Beacons of Light is a process of pastoral planning to best arrange our many resources – human, financial, physical – to pursue the God-given mission of sharing the Gospel throughout our archdiocese. I am grateful to everyone who has come together as a Family of Parishes and begun to discern how the Spirit of God is working among us. Beacons of Light will only be successful under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and only if our parishes are communities of faith truly centered on our Eucharistic Lord.

In this phase of the Eucharistic Revival, my brother bishops and I are encouraging the Church in the United States to greater Eucharistic devotion, especially through more life-giving, beautiful, and transformative celebrations of the Eucharist every Sunday. All those who lead the Church at prayer – priests, deacons, and lay liturgical ministers – are called to prepare for and celebrate the liturgy with fidelity to the text and rubrics given by the Church. Our liturgical leaders must also create measures of true hospitality, and ensure excellent preaching and sacred music, so that all may more fully encounter Jesus' true and abiding presence each time we come to Mass.

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, we invoke, “Grant your Church, O Lord, we pray, the gifts of unity and peace, whose signs are to be seen in mystery in the offerings we here present.” We ask our Lord in a special way that our celebrations of the Eucharist truly foster unity, not only in our Families of Parishes, but across our entire archdiocese. This *unity* – not *uniformity* – is a cornerstone to building up the Catholic Church in these nineteen counties of western and southwestern Ohio.

As we move into the summer months, I invite you and your family to join me in praying for the success of both Beacons of Light and the National Eucharistic Revival. Thank you for your prayerful support of your pastor and parish leaders. May the Spirit of God continue to lead us to deeper participation in the Eucharist and to bear the fruits of that mystery to a world desperately in need of God's love.
