Please note that during the school year, Mass at Holy Rosary begins at 8:15 on Tuesdays and Mass at Immaculate Conception begins at 9:00am on Fridays to accommodate the school day. 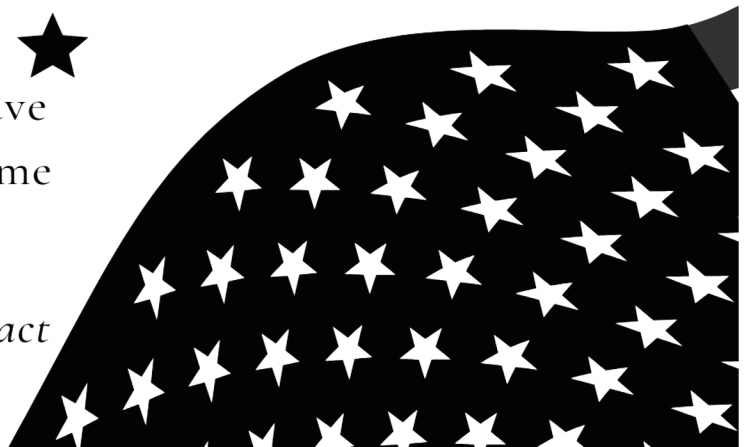
