

1. Prayer: Fr. John opened the meeting with prayer.

2. St. Isidore the Farmer, Family of Parishes Bulletin

Erik Bonilla shared that the first Family bulletin will be available on December 10th. The bulletin company will be LPI. The bulletin will consist of 10-12 pages. Information and events that need to be in the bulletin will need to be sent to Erik Bonilla by Tuesday at 11:00 am. The bulletin will be made available in print, on the St. Isidore the Farmer, Family of Parishes Webpage and promoted on the Facebook page as well.

Erik will be contacting each church office about advertisers for the bulletin in the near future.

Erik will also be putting a committee together to discuss the layout for the Family bulletin. He has asked that the members of Pastoral council from each church send him a name of someone that can serve on this committee by 9/29/23.

3. Mass Schedule / Poll Information

The poll data that was collected was shared with the group.

- Data shows that the majority of parishioners are happy with the available times in the Family.
- A discussion was had about meeting the Beacons Guidelines for two Masses for a Priest on a day and how we currently are not meeting this guideline. This is important for not only meeting a guideline, but also for making it possible to cover Masses when our priests are on vacation or if they are sick. We need to do what we can to keep our priests healthy.
- The Archbishop can tell our Family "no" in maintaining a schedule outside the guidelines if he deems it is needed. He is the only one that can give these privileges to the priests to say more than 2 Masses on a regular basis.
- Different configurations were discussed, but none of these seemed to fit our needs.
- The Pastoral Council and Fr. John have come to a decision to maintain the current schedule for the near future with the understanding that a Mass could be canceled due to a priest getting sick and not having a sub priest available last
- It was discussed that there are only 2 priests at St. Charles that are capable to come out and say Masses. They are being called from many parishes to help. There may be a time that they will not be able or are already scheduled somewhere else. We have 2 other priests from Ludlow Falls coming and helping our family, but they would not be able to be here quickly in a last-minute illness.

4. Open Discussion

Pilot: Fr. John shared an update on the pilot being conducted by the Archdiocese to have the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI) help us prepare for canonical unification of our parishes. We have a group of individuals representing all of the churches in the family that is meeting with a liaison from CLI to discuss options that are on the table for the future and how we bring these 5 churches together as one Canonical Parish. There has been one in-person meeting and one online meeting.

The next steps are to form a focus group to discuss the options and look at the benefits and disadvantages for each option. This is a pilot that allows us to review each possibility with many parishioners without having to move forward at this time with any option in the near future. We are able to take the time needed to evaluate and confidently move forward when the time is right.

The focus group will include the Pastoral Council, principals, and a person from each finance committee, the directors and the business managers. Tentative date for the focus group meeting is October 7th. We are hoping to have this meeting before the next in-person meeting for the pilot group on October 19.

Fr. Prashanth: Everyone was reminded to keep Fr. Prashanth in our prayers for a safe trip home to India and back to the St. Isidore the Farmer, Family of Parishes.

A **Deanery Pastoral Council Convocation** is being held for each deanery in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. This is for all Unified Pastoral Council members, leadership members of the staff and Priests. This is being held at McCartyville at Sacred Heart of Jesus Church. This will take the place of our next Pastoral Council meeting.
