Attention

There has been a report out of Covington, Ohio of an individual impersonating as a Roman Catholic Priest going by the name of "Father" Scott Benedict Davis or "Bishop" Scott Benedict Davis and stating that he is affiliated with the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. This person also uses social media accounts under the name of Sancti Benedicti Monasterium. This person is not a priest and is not affiliated with the Archdiocese. Please be aware of this information as he has attempted to solicit monetary donations while impersonating a priest. The Archdiocese is aware of this situation and have taken the necessary steps.
