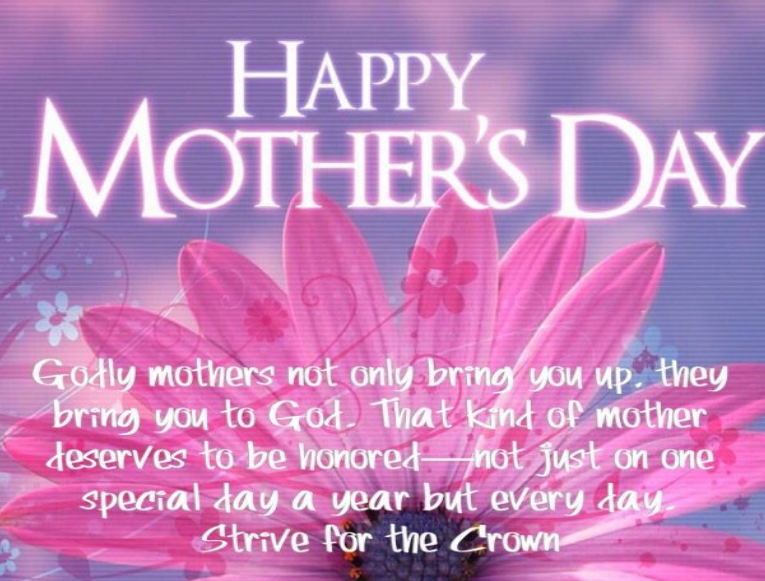

Today's Gospel Reflections - *Mark 16:15-20*

Jesus is taken to heaven, and the disciples go forth to preach as Jesus commanded.

There are similarities in the reports of Jesus' Ascension found in the Synoptic Gospels—Mark, Matthew, and Luke. In each case, Jesus assigns his disciples the task of proclaiming the gospel message to the entire world. There are also notable distinctions. In the Gospels of Mark and Matthew, the disciples are sent by Jesus to baptize and to preach. In Luke's Gospel, however, the commission to baptize is absent. Instead, Jesus directs the disciples to return to Jerusalem to await the fulfillment of his promise to send them the Holy Spirit. Curiously, only the Gospels of Mark and Luke actually report Jesus' ascension into heaven. Matthew's Gospel concludes with Jesus' promise to remain with his disciples forever. Only the Gospel of Mark notes that Jesus ascended to sit at the right hand of God. In noting this, Mark teaches that Jesus' ascension affirms the glory Jesus received from God after his death and Resurrection

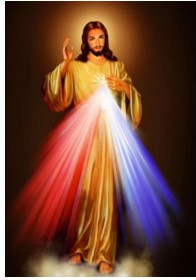

Reflexión del Evangelio de hoy—*Marcos 16:15-20*

Jesús es llevado al cielo y los discípulos salen a predicar como Jesús ordenó.

Hay similitudes en los informes de la Ascensión de Jesús que se encuentran en los evangelios sinópticos: Marcos, Mateo y Lucas. En cada caso, Jesús asigna a sus discípulos la tarea de proclamar el mensaje del evangelio al mundo entero. También hay distinciones notables. En los evangelios de Marcos y Mateo, los discípulos son enviados por Jesús a bautizar y predicar. Sin embargo, en el evangelio de Lucas no existe la comisión de bautizar. En cambio, Jesús ordena a los discípulos que regresen a Jerusalén para esperar el cumplimiento de su promesa de enviarles el Espíritu Santo. Curiosamente, sólo los evangelios de Marcos y Lucas relatan realmente la ascensión de Jesús al cielo. El Evangelio de Mateo concluye con la promesa de Jesús de permanecer con sus discípulos para siempre. Sólo el Evangelio de Marcos señala que Jesús ascendió para sentarse a la diestra de Dios. Al señalar esto, Marcos enseña que la ascensión de Jesús afirma la gloria que Jesús recibió de Dios después de su muerte y resurrección.

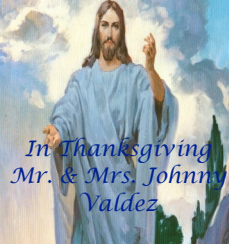

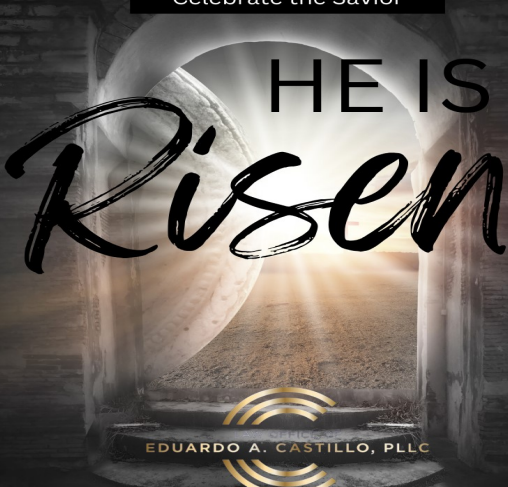
