Today's Gospel Reflection Mark 13:24-32

Jesus teaches about the signs of the coming of the Son of Man.

Jesus instruct his disciples about the need for watchfulness so that they will not be caught unprepared for this final day of judgment.

In today's Gospel, Jesus continues this teaching by offering his disciples signs to look for that will indicate that the coming of the Son of Man is near. His words and images draw upon Old Testament imagery, especially images found in the Book of Daniel. Next, Jesus offers the lesson of the fig tree, a parable that teaches that if one knows how to read the signs, one can be prepared for the end times. Jesus also teaches, however, that no one knows when the end time will come, except the Father. In the verses that follow this reading in Mark's Gospel, Jesus continues to warn his disciples to be on watch for this end time.

Jesus' words are not spoken to frighten his disciples, nor should they frighten us. Rather, they are offered to prepare us for the changes we will experience during our lifetimes and at the end times. Our consolation and hope is found in the lasting nature of Jesus' words and God's never-ending love for us.

Reflexión del Evangelio de Hoy - Marcos 13, 24-32

Jesús enseña sobre las señales de la venida del Hijo del Hombre.

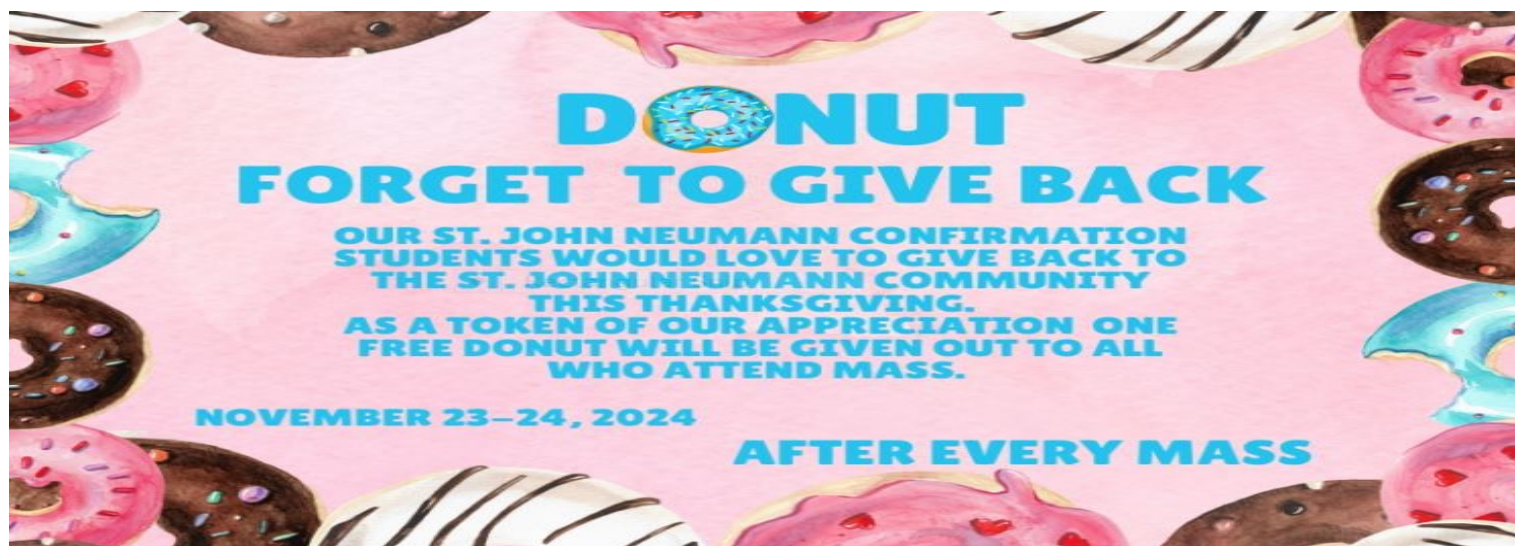
Jesús instruyó a sus discípulos sobre la necesidad de estar atentos para que no fueran tomados desprevenidos para este día final del juicio.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús continúa esta enseñanza ofreciendo a sus discípulos señales para indicarles que la venida del Hijo del Hombre está cerca. Sus palabras e imágenes se basan en imágenes del Antiguo Testamento, especialmente imágenes que se encuentran en el Libro de Daniel. A continuación, Jesús ofrece la lección de la higuera, una parábola que enseña que si uno sabe leer las señales, puede estar preparado para el fin de los tiempos. Jesús también enseña, sin embargo, que nadie sabe cuándo llegará el fin de los tiempos, excepto el Padre. En los versículos que siguen a esta lectura en el Evangelio de Marcos, Jesús continúa advirtiéndole a sus discípulos que estén atentos a este tiempo final.

Las palabras de Jesús no fueron dichas para asustar a sus discípulos, ni deberían asustarnos a nosotros. Más bien, se ofrecen para prepararnos para los cambios que experimentaremos durante nuestras vidas y en los últimos tiempos. Nuestro consuelo y esperanza se encuentran en la naturaleza duradera de las palabras de Jesús y en el amor infinito de Dios por nosotros.

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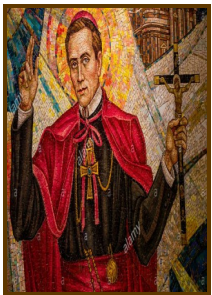
