Today's Gospel Reflection John 18:33b-37

Jesus is questioned by Pilate about the charge brought against him that he is "King of the Jews."

In today's reading, we hear one of two dialogues between Jesus and Pilate that are reported in John's Gospel. Pilate questions Jesus about the charges brought against him. Caiaphas and the high priests have charged Jesus with a political crime, one that would require a punishment of death. Pilate distances himself from the Jewish leaders who accuse Jesus; he is not a Jew, and he seems to want little to do with this Jewish affair.

In his responses to Pilate's questions, Jesus distinguishes his kingdom from the political powers of this world. Jesus is king, but not the kind of king we imagine or expect. He was certainly not the kind of king Pilate feared he might be.

In today's reading, we see Jesus identify the final proof that his kingdom is not of this world: If his kingdom were of this world, then there would be people fighting to save him. Those who know the truth will recognize Jesus as king and will know how to interpret this insight. Only those chosen, those who have the eyes of faith, are able to see. As modern disciples of Jesus, we also struggle at times to recognize Jesus as king. Today's Gospel invites us to see with eyes of faith that we might recognize that Jesus, through his crucifixion and death, is indeed king and Savior of all.

Reflexión del Evangelio de Hoy - Juan 18, 33b-37

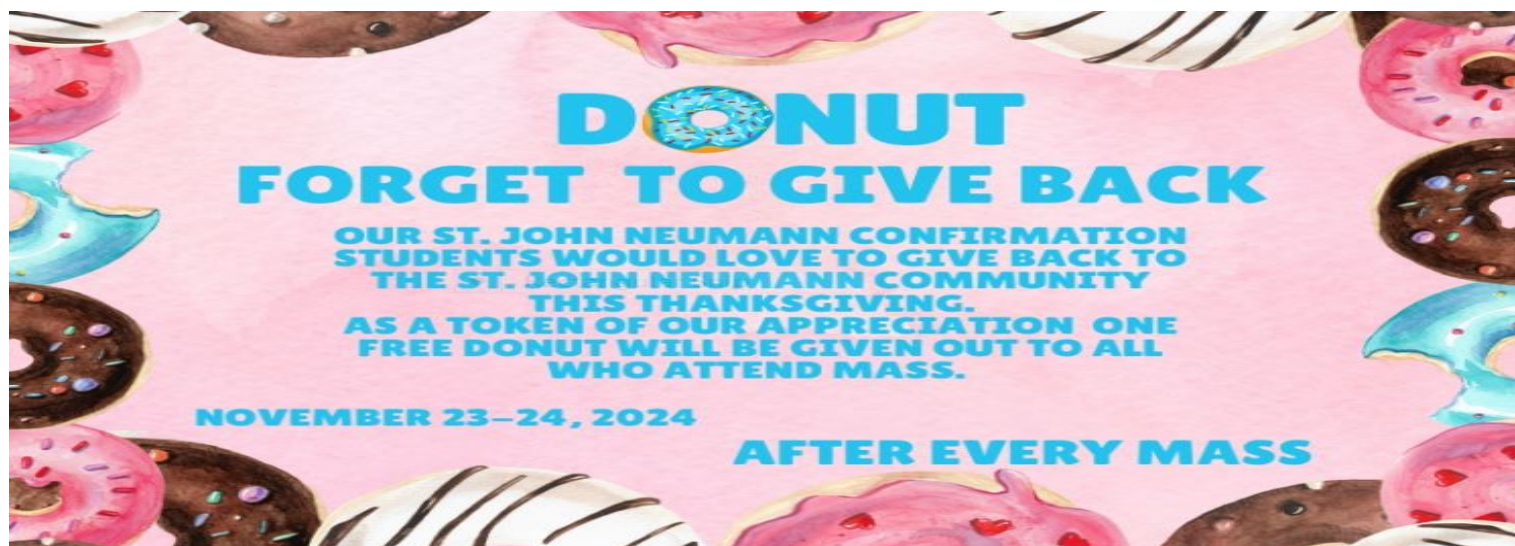
Jesús Pilato interroga a Jesús sobre la acusación que se le imputa de que es "Rey de los judíos".

En la lectura de hoy, escuchamos uno de los dos diálogos entre Jesús y Pilato que se relatan en el Evangelio de Juan. Pilato interroga a Jesús sobre los cargos que se le imputan. Caifás y los sumos sacerdotes han acusado a Jesús de un delito político que requeriría la pena de muerte. Pilato se distancia de los líderes judíos que acusan a Jesús; no es judío y parece querer tener poco que ver con este asunto judío.

En sus respuestas a las preguntas de Pilato, Jesús distingue su reino de los poderes políticos de este mundo. Jesús es rey, pero no el tipo de rey que imaginamos o esperamos. Ciertamente no era el tipo de rey que Pilato temía que fuera.

En la lectura de hoy, vemos a Jesús identificar la prueba final de que su reino no es de este mundo: si su reino fuera de este mundo, entonces habría gente luchando para salvarlo. Quienes conozcan la verdad reconocerán a Jesús como rey y sabrán interpretar esta intuición. Sólo los elegidos, los que tienen los ojos de la fe, pueden ver. Como discípulos modernos de Jesús, a veces también nos cuesta reconocer a Jesús como rey. El Evangelio de hoy nos invita a ver con ojos de fe para que podamos reconocer que Jesús, a través de su crucifixión y muerte, es en verdad Rey y Salvador de todos.

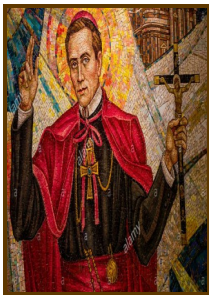
