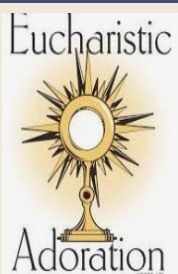
URGENT MESSAGE FROM FR. PEDROZA TO ALL MINISTRIES!

Today's Gospel Reflection - Luke 10:1-12,17-20

Jesus sends out 72 people to announce the coming kingdom.

Today's Gospel begins immediately after the final verse in last Sunday's Gospel. After strong language about the difficulties of discipleship, Jesus immediately appoints 72 people to go ahead of him to every town and place he plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He sends them in pairs. In the Law of Moses two witnesses were needed for a testimony to be credible. It was probably also a safer way to travel.

Jesus admits it will be difficult, that he is sending them out like lambs among wolves. Yet they are to bring nothing with them, not even a money bag or sandals. They are to greet no one on the way so as not to be distracted from their mission. When they enter a house, their message is simply "peace." The response they will receive may be positive or negative. Either way, they are to know that the Kingdom of God is at hand. They are not to demand special treatment but eat and drink whatever is given them. They are to stay in one house and are not to look around for one that provides better accommodations. They are to heal the sick as a sign that the Kingdom of God is at hand for them. Like Jesus' miracles, healing is a sign of the coming of the kingdom. If the town will not receive them, they are to shake the dust from their feet and move on. Even in the case of such rejection they should know that the Kingdom of God is at hand.

When they return from their journeys, they are rejoicing because their mission has been successful. Demons were under their power because of Jesus' name. Jesus may have sent them out as lambs among wolves, but at the conclusion of this passage he assures them that they have been given power over the enemy and nothing will harm them, not even serpents and scorpions.

A key theme of today's Gospel and last Sunday's Gospel is discipleship—its challenges, its difficulties, and its rewards. Sharing in the mission of Jesus is difficult, but everyone is called to do it, not just some professionals trained for ministry. Even for us today, the harvest is plentiful. We should pray to the master of the harvest to send out workers for his harvest.

Reflexión del Evangelio de hoy ~ Lucas 10:1-12,17-20

Jesús envía a 72 personas a anunciar la venida del reino.

El Evangelio de hoy comienza inmediatamente después del último versículo del Evangelio del domingo pasado. Tras un lenguaje contundente sobre las dificultades del discipulado, Jesús designa inmediatamente a 72 personas para que lo precedan en cada pueblo y lugar que planea visitar, proclamando que el Reino de Dios está cerca. Los envía de dos en dos. En la Ley de Moisés se necesitaban dos testigos para que un testimonio fuera creíble. Probablemente también era una forma más segura de viajar.

Jesús admite que será difícil, que los envía como corderos en medio de lobos. Sin embargo, no deben llevar nada consigo, ni siquiera una bolsa de dinero ni sandalias. No deben saludar a nadie en el camino para no distraerse de su misión. Al entrar en una casa, su mensaje es simplemente «paz». La respuesta que recibirán puede ser positiva o negativa. En cualquier caso, deben saber que el Reino de Dios está cerca. No deben exigir un trato especial, sino comer y beber lo que se les dé. Deben alojarse en una casa y no buscar una que ofrezca mejor alojamiento. Deben sanar a los enfermos como señal de que el Reino de Dios está cerca para ellos. Al igual que los milagros de Jesús, la sanación es señal de la venida del reino. Si el pueblo no los recibe, deben sacudirse el polvo de los pies y seguir adelante. Incluso en caso de rechazo, deben saber que el Reino de Dios está cerca.

Al regresar de sus viajes, se regocijaban porque su misión había sido un éxito. Los demonios estaban bajo su poder por el nombre de Jesús. Jesús pudo haberlos enviado como corderos en medio de lobos, pero al final de este pasaje les asegura que se les ha dado poder sobre el enemigo y que nada les hará daño, ni siquiera serpientes ni escorpiones.

Un tema clave del Evangelio de hoy y del domingo pasado es el discipulado: sus desafíos, sus dificultades y sus recompensas. Participar en la misión de Jesús es difícil, pero todos están llamados a hacerlo, no solo algunos profesionales capacitados para el ministerio. Incluso para nosotros hoy, la cosecha es abundante. Debemos orar al dueño de la mies para que envíe obreros a su cosecha.

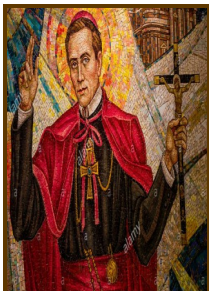

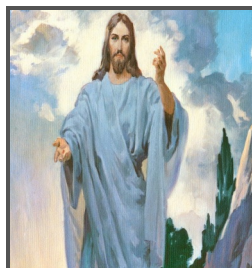
