Today's Gospel Reflection - John 4:5-42**Jesus reveals himself to the Samaritan woman at the well.**

On this Sunday and the next two Sundays, we break from reading the Gospel of Matthew to read from John's Gospel. In today's Gospel, the dialogue between Jesus and a woman from Samaria is among the most lengthy and most theological found in Scripture. Jesus, an observant Jew of that time, was expected to avoid conversation with women in public. The woman herself alludes to the break from tradition: "How can you, a Jew, ask me, a Samaritan woman, for a drink?" Yet Jesus not only converses with the woman, he also asks to share her drinking vessel, an action that makes him unclean according to Jewish law. At first, the woman understands Jesus' promise of "living water" in a literal sense: "Sir, give me this water, so that I may not be thirsty or have to keep coming here to draw water." The high point of the conversation is when Jesus reveals himself to her as the Messiah. After the conversation, the Samaritan woman becomes a disciple. Having come to know Jesus as the Messiah, the Samaritan woman becomes an evangelist to her own people. Jesus uses his encounter with the Samaritan woman to teach his disciples that God's mercy is without limit.

Reflexion del Evangelio de hoy - Juan 4:5-42**Jesús se revela a la mujer samaritana en el pozo.**

Este domingo y los dos siguientes, dejamos de leer el Evangelio de Mateo para leer el Evangelio de Juan. En el Evangelio actual, el diálogo entre Jesús y una mujer de Samaria es uno de los más extensos y teológicos que se encuentran en las Escrituras. Jesús, un judío observante de aquella época, se esperaba que evitara conversar con mujeres en público. La propia mujer alude a la ruptura con la tradición: "¿Cómo puedes tú, judío, pedirme a mí, una samaritana, una copa?" Sin embargo, Jesús no solo conversa con la mujer, sino que también le pide compartir su recipiente para beber, una acción que lo vuelve impuro según la ley judía. Al principio, la mujer entiende literalmente la promesa de Jesús de "agua viva": "Señor, dame esta agua, para que no tenga sed ni tenga que venir aquí a sacar agua." El punto culminante de la conversación es cuando Jesús se revela ante ella como el Mesías. Tras la conversación, la mujer samaritana se convierte en discípula. Habiendo llegado a conocer a Jesús como el Mesías, la mujer samaritana se convierte en evangelista de su propio pueblo. Jesús utiliza su encuentro con la samaritana para enseñar a sus discípulos que la misericordia de Dios no tiene límites.


