What is it that keeps us from responding as we should?

There are various obstacles that hinder or prevent us from encountering God, and responding as we should.

A prime obstacle we all have to overcome is self-centeredness.

The more we are wrapped up in ourselves, the more isolated we become from God, and the less likely we are to encounter God in our lives.

There is another obstacle to encountering God, and responding to God's invitation, indifference, lack of care or concern about whether we encounter God or not.

It consists in being preoccupied with so many other things.

We miss his invitations.

The Cathedral of Chartres in France is world-renowned for its architecture, for the beauty of its design and workmanship.

One of the carved stone figures high up in an arch of that cathedral depicts God holding Adam ever so tenderly in his lap.

Adam is asleep with his chin on his chest, and his arms and legs drawn up closely to his body, almost in a fetal position.

God is looking at him with deep care and compassion, as though he longed for his grace

to awaken Adam from his sleep and, thus,

to become aware of the one whose arms hold him, and of how much he is loved.

What a beautiful image for us to cherish and ponder!
