**FOURTH SUNDAY
OF LENT**

What the son receives from his
father is pure grace

The primary task of the second half of life is
that of grieving.

We need to grieve, or the bitterness and an-
ger
that come from our wounds, disappoint-
ments,
bad choices and broken dreams will over-
whelm us
with the sense of life's unfairness.

Life is unfair. Don't try to protect yourself
from its hurts—
you've already been hurt! Accept that,
grieve it
and move on to rejoice the dance

In the end, it is because we are wounded
and bitter
that we worry about God's justice,
worry that it might be too lenient,
worry that the bad will not be fully pun-
ished,
worry that there might not be a hell.

But we should worry less about those things
and more about our own incapacity to for-
give,
to let go of our own hurts, to take delight in
life,
to give others the sheer gaze of admiration,
to celebrate and to truly join in the dance.

Update to all Parishioners: 3RCs has partnered
up with the **St. Vincent de Paul** organization of St.
Mary's, with their "**Cans Can Make a Difference**"
program. Now your generous donations of Cans
and Bottles can reach further to help the needs of
the lower income and less fortunate individuals
and families in need. Our system of operation is
also changing to become more efficient and for
safer handling of returnables. It's simple: take 1 or
2 green bags (or more if needed) located at the
3RCs receptacle site in the breezeway. Once the
bags are filled tie it securely and drop it back to the
receptacle site, then repeat the process. Note—
glass bottles can be mixed with cans **BUT NOT** too
many in a bag (up to 10). If you have a lot of bottles
bring them in your own bag or box. Thank you for
your cooperation. Remember this program is Lent
friendly— by donating your cans & bottles you are
fulfilling part of your **Alms Giving** obligation in this
season of **Lent**. If you don't have returnables to
donate and still want to donate to this worthy
cause you're welcome to use the St. Vincent de Paul
envelope located in the Pews.
