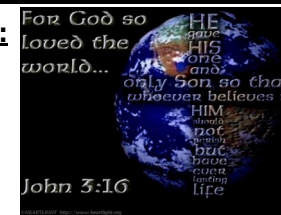

A Message from Your Pastor:

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ,
The Peace and Love of Jesus be with you.



We have come to the last day in the month of May. In a special way, during this month, we have been praying the rosary and growing spiritually by the help of our Blessed Mother. Today the Holy Mother Church celebrates the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. It teaches us that there are three distinct Persons in One God, sharing the same Divine Nature, co-equal and co-eternal. Our human mind cannot grasp this doctrine. But we believe in this Mystery because Jesus, who is God, taught it clearly, it is recorded by the Evangelists. The Fathers of the Church tried to explain it, and the councils of Nicaea and Constantinople defined it as a dogma of Christian Faith. It is good to remember the importance of the Holy Trinity in our own life. We begin all our prayers by invoking the name of the Holy Trinity.

The Sacraments that are administered to us are done in the name of the Holy Trinity. We bless ourselves and others in the name of the Holy Trinity. Therefore, let us respect ourselves and others because we are the Temples of the Holy Spirit. Let us continue to build on our firm conviction that the Trinitarian God abides in us. He is the source of our hope, courage and strength. Let us practice the Trinitarian relationship of Love and Unity in our family and in our community.

The month of June is dedicated to Sacred Heart of Jesus. Let us be united with our Archbishop, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Religious, and the People of God in the act of consecrating ourselves and our families to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Happy Sunday and have a great weekend. God bless you.
