Pastor's Note:



Evangelization. "The Church exists in order to evangelize," says Pope Paul VI in his Apostolic Exhortation (1975) *Evangelii Nuntiandi* (Evangelization in the Modern World). By Church, the people of God, to proclaim Jesus and the Gospel (Good News of Salvation) to all peoples is manifold. Basically, it is understood as to send missionaries to all corners of the world to preach or to teach the faith. Evangelization is also living our own Christian vocation wherever and however we are called by God. You do not have to be ordained or profess religious vows in order to proclaim Christ and his Gospel to all peoples. In fact, by being baptized, one is gifted the grace to be able to witness to Christ by practicing Christian virtues at all times. The home is practically the most common place and environment where each baptized is logically a preacher and evangelizer. The home is the domestic church where all the baptized of that unit together praise God's name and share the presence of Christ to each other. I received catechism from home. Even before school age, I remember, I got to know basic church teachings on prayer and worship from my grandparents and parents. We prayed together. We always talked about things with God or a church teaching serving as its foundation or background. Hence, it was ingrained in our thoughts, speech and actions; God and his Church.

How does this impact the universal proclamation of the Name of Jesus and the coming of God's Kingdom?

Imagine if all Catholic homes lived up to the expectation of their baptismal responsibility; that would be a great way the world is evangelized. "For they will know that we are Christians by our love." (John 13:35)
