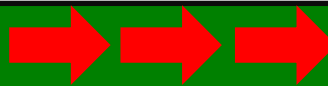

Are We Ignoring the “Least” of Our Brothers and Sisters?

Jesus told us what He will say to us at the Last Judgement, at the end of the world: “. . . Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of Mine, you did for Me.” (Mt. 25:40)

There are many in our society whose needs are often ignored: the poor, the immigrants, the handicapped, the elderly and the terminally ill. But the ones who are the easiest to ignore are the tiny prenatal babies whom we have never seen. Those very young boys and girls have no way to plead for our love and protection. Instead they are often forgotten by euphemisms such as “the right to choose.”

If we could somehow see the unborn babies inside of their mothers, it would be much more difficult to ignore them. With modern technology, it is possible to see amazing images of those children before they are born, **such as the one below of a 12 week old prenatal baby sucking her thumb.** In fact, those who see clear ultrasound images of tiny prenatal boys and girls are much more inclined to love and protect them, instead of having them killed by abortion.

Almost everyone agrees that all **NEWBORN** babies deserve our love and protection. This is true even when newborn babies are sick or handicapped, when their parents are poor or when they are in other difficult circumstances. Shouldn't the same be true of prenatal babies, who are also members of the human family? **Yes, those “least” members of the human family also deserve our love and protection!**

Jesus not only taught us how to treat others, He also showed us the greatness of His Divine Mercy. This needs to be remembered by any of God's children who have failed to love and protect prenatal babies as we should. When we are sorry for the wrong we have done, God longs to forgive us in the great Sacrament of Mercy, the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession).

Please join me next Sunday, January 25, for the Pro-Life Rosary Walk. We will begin at 2:00 pm, walking the 2 miles from the corner of Boston St. and Santa Ursula to San Agustin Cathedral, praying the Rosary as we ask God to restore respect for the sanctity of every human life, from conception to natural death. May the Blessed Virgin Mary, who greatly loved the prenatal Jesus she carried within her, help us to love and protect the “least” of our brothers and sisters!



¿Estamos ignorando a los "más pequeños" de nuestros hermanos y hermanas?

Jesús nos dijo lo que nos dirá en el Juicio Final, al final del mundo:

"En verdad les digo que cuanto hicieron por uno de estos hermanos míos más pequeños, a mí me lo hicieron." (Mt 25,40)

En nuestra sociedad hay muchas personas cuyas necesidades son con frecuencia ignoradas: los pobres, los inmigrantes, las personas con discapacidad, los ancianos y los enfermos terminales. Pero los más fáciles de ignorar son los pequeños bebés no nacidos que nunca hemos visto. Estos niños y niñas tan pequeños no tienen manera de pedir nuestro amor y nuestra protección. En cambio, a menudo son olvidados detrás de expresiones como "el derecho a elegir".

Si pudiéramos ver de alguna manera a los bebés no nacidos dentro del vientre de sus madres, sería mucho más difícil ignorarlos. Con la tecnología moderna es posible ver imágenes sorprendentes de estos niños antes de que nazcan, **como la que se muestra abajo de una bebé de 12 semanas chupándose el dedo**. De hecho, quienes ven imágenes claras de ultrasonido de estos pequeños niños y niñas tienden mucho más a amarlos y protegerlos, en lugar de permitir que sean eliminados por el aborto.

Casi todos están de acuerdo en que todos los bebés **RECIENTE NACIDOS** merecen nuestro amor y nuestra protección. Esto es cierto incluso cuando los bebés están enfermos o tienen alguna discapacidad, cuando sus padres son pobres o cuando se encuentran en otras circunstancias difíciles. ¿No debería ser lo mismo con los bebés no nacidos, que también son miembros de la familia humana? **Sí, esos "más pequeños" miembros de la familia humana también merecen nuestro amor y nuestra protección.**

Jesús no solo nos enseñó cómo tratar a los demás, sino que también nos mostró la grandeza de su Misericordia Divina. Esto debe ser recordado por todos los hijos de Dios que no han amado ni protegido a los bebés no nacidos como deberían. Cuando nos arrepentimos del mal que hemos hecho, Dios anhela perdonarnos en el gran Sacramento de la Misericordia, el Sacramento de la Reconciliación (Confesión).

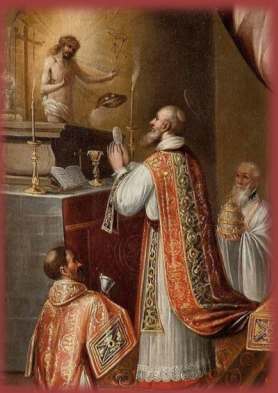
