St. Peter Handbook Guidelines for School Health Safety

- Students should remain home and be fever-free for 24 hours after having registered a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher.
- If a student is vomiting or has diarrhea before school, please keep them home until at least 24 hours after it subsides.
- All persistent rashes should be seen by a doctor for proper diagnosis in order to determine the communicability of the rash.
- If a student has a discolored (yellow to green) nasal discharge, this may indicate infection, and parents will be called to pick up the student.
- All students with head lice are to be checked back into school with one of the
 following: doctor's note, health unit slip from a clinic, or a written confirmation from
 any recognized business that specializes in treatment of lice.
- All ringworms must be covered while at school.
- Report all communicable diseases to the school i.e. Chickenpox, Fifth Disease, etc.
- All chickenpox sores should be completely dry before the student returns to school.




