Dear Friends,

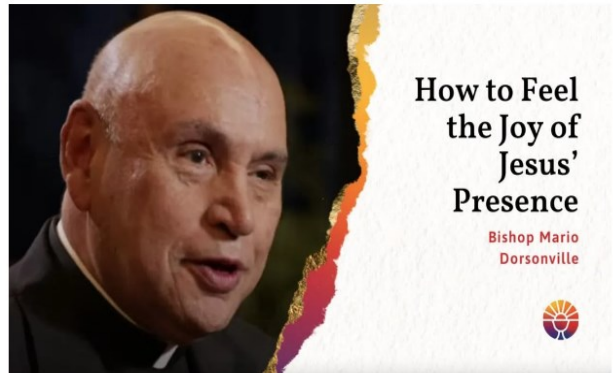

Nauma-Thibodaux Bishop Dorsonville, 63

Bishop Mario E. Dorsonville, a native of Bogota, Colombia, who was installed less than a year ago as bishop of the Diocese of Nauma-Thibodaux, died Jan. 19 at Ochsner Medical Center in Kenner after complications from a heart attack.

He was 63.

Before coming to Nauma-Thibodaux, Bishop Peter Egan, vicar general of the Diocese of Nauma-Thibodaux, said Dorsonville was a "man of

refined culture, religious and social values, and a man of the bishop's own kind in faithfulness and faithfulness evoking."

At his funeral address and deep shock that I anticipate the bishop's death, Bishop Dorsonville, passed away at 6:50 p.m. Jan. 19 after he gave in to complications arising from a heart attack.

Further Egan wrote: "I ask you to pray for the soul of Bishop Dorsonville, and we begin to navigate through the grief of his death."

On the 95th anniversary of King's birth, these letters shed new light on his excommunication. The letters show that King supported Father Twomey's own advocacy. Father Twomey, a co-drafter of Jesuit Father General Pedro Arrupe's 1967 Letter on the Interracial Apostolate, played a key role in motivating U.S. Jesuits to promote civil rights.

Father Twomey grew up in Florida without questioning his privileged status as a white
