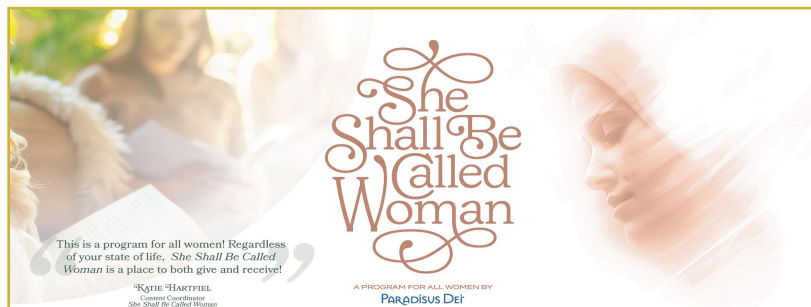

Daniel P. Burns, Ph.D., held positions as theologian and Chief Academic Officer at St. Joseph Seminary College since 2007 and now holds the position of Director of Lay Ministry Programs at Notre Dame Seminary since July 2023. He oversees the Institute for Lay Ecclesial Ministry (ILEM) and the Master of Arts in Pastoral Leadership (MAPL) programs. A Louisiana native, Dr. Burns earned his B.A. in Philosophy from St. Joseph Seminary College in 1997, an M.A. in Theology from Notre Dame Seminary in 2004, and a Ph.D. in Theology from Loyola University Chicago in 2011.

He is married to Christi, with whom he has four children, and has been an active parishioner of St. Peter Parish since 2007. With extensive experience in seminary formation, he brings a special zeal for vocational awareness, and liturgical precision to the Saint Peter Altar Server Corps, where he acts as the head of our robust altar boy ministry.

We are grateful to our parishioner Dr. Burns to share his love for Our Lady and his theological expertise in a four-part academic on series Mary, commencing this September.

THE MARONITE CHURCH AND THE ST. SHARBEL MISSION

The Maronite Church is an Eastern Catholic Church in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. While it has unique traditions and rituals, it recognizes the authority of the Pope in Rome. The Maronite community celebrates the Eucharist, blending ancient practices with broader Catholic traditions. Rooted in the ancient tradition from Antioch, the Maronite Rite's Divine Liturgy (Mass) has a similar structure to the Roman Rite, with the liturgy in Syriac, Aramaic, and English.

The Diocese of Baton Rouge hosts the nearest Maronite Church. To reach their people spread across South Louisiana, the Maronite Church in Baton Rouge has a mission outreach in Covington at Saint Peter Church. The Saint Sharbel Mission offers a Divine Liturgy at Saint Peter on a monthly basis. Parishioners are invited to attend this unique and beautiful celebration of the Maronite Divine Liturgy, which fulfills the obligation for Sunday Mass when offered on a Saturday evening or Sunday.

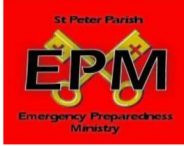


Hurricane Season is June through November

As such, families should prepare themselves for those potential disasters that sometimes affect our homes here in south Louisiana. Hurricanes top the list, it seems, so here are a few preparations a family can take during the season to “Be Prepared.”

- Discuss the types of hazards that could affect your family. Know your home’s vulnerability to storm surge, flooding, and wind.
- Locate a safe room or the safest areas in your home for each hurricane hazard. In certain circumstances the safest areas may not be your home, but within your community.
- Determine escape routes from your home and places to meet afterward. These should be measured in tens of miles rather than hundreds of miles.
- Have an out-of-state friend as a family contact so that all of your family members have a single point of contact through which to communicate if you become separated.
- Make a plan now for what to do with your pets if you need to evacuate.
- Post emergency telephone numbers in a handy place and make sure your children know how and when to use them, or to call 911.
- Check your insurance coverage – flood damage is not usually covered by homeowners insurance.
- Stock non-perishable emergency supplies and create a “Disaster Supply Kit.”
- Use a NOAA weather radio. Remember to replace its batteries every 6 months as you would with your smoke detectors.
- Take First Aid, CPR, and Disaster Preparedness classes.

Pet Care Emergency Planning

When an emergency/disaster occurs, confusion and turmoil usually reign supreme. It is difficult at such a time to remember all the important things that need to be done. Making the proper pet care plans can become more difficult if not done in advance.

The following are just a few questions that may need answers:

- Will you evacuate your pet(s) along with your family in the event of an emergency? If so, will the hotel you plan to use in transit allow pets?
- Have you created a list of items such as medications, special food, water, etc. needed to provide proper care for your pet(s) during an evacuation?
- Have you created in advance a kit containing all of the pet necessities on that list?
- Will it be necessary for you to board your pet locally until you return home? With what local pet facility will you board and at what cost?
- Sometimes the questions can be more difficult if not impossible to answer, such as how long will the evacuation continue? Making arrangements with the animal caretaker even for protracted evacuations may be an important issue to discuss in advance. Of course, not all questions can be answered, but by asking the questions you can be better prepared to deal with most eventualities you may encounter with emergencies.
