The Blessing Of Ashes

There's an interesting phenomenon at work in this annual, very public ritual (and it's not exclusive to Catholics; other Christians mark their foreheads with ashes to commemorate the start of Lent). While in some parts of the world it's become less common to see people in the workplace, the grocery store, or anywhere in public with big black smudges on their foreheads, it is still one of the rare times when our faith becomes a truly public witness.

For me, one of the beautiful things about Catholicism is the cyclical repetition of the liturgical calendar. The ebb and flow of seasons, feasts and fasts, reappearances each year of an old saint (friend) give us a chance to revisit familiar times in the life of Christ and the history of the Church – often with fresh eyes. As with so many of the rituals of our outward expressions of faith (and even the most rote of gestures!), there is so much depth, so much meaning under the surface. And we might miss some little detail even as we repeatedly participate for decades, only to land upon it in astonishment on the 99th go-round!
