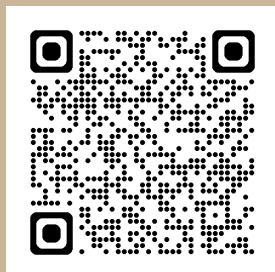

WHAT I HAVE SEEN AND HEARD



Dear Friends,
This week, we look at **the Twelfth Rule of the fourteen rules of St. Ignatius**. This rule asks the question: **When is the best time to resist temptations?** This rule basically invites us to **resist temptation with courage at the beginning**. Waiting would only compound the effect of the temptation like a small snowball going down a hill. St. Ignatius puts it thus: "... it is the way of the enemy (like A spoiled child) to weaken and lose heart, his temptations taking flight, when the person who is exercising himself in spiritual things opposes a bold front against the temptations of the enemy, doing diametrically the opposite. And on the contrary, if the person who is exercising himself commences to have fear and lose heart in suffering the temptations, there is no beast so wild on the face of the earth as the enemy of human nature in following out his damnable intention with so great malice." The best way to overcome temptations is to fight them at the beginning with all our might!

Today, we come to the end of the 2026 **Catholic Schools Week**. This year's theme is: "**Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community**." Catholic schools are a product of our faith community and a gift to our faith community. I exhort us to encourage our kids and grandkids to make use of Catholic education at all levels especially our own St. Mary's Academy in the deanery.

This week, moving forward, we begin **the Archbishop's Annual Appeal**. The theme for this year is: "**We are One Body in Christ: Called to Serve**." For the past years I have been here, we have met our goal and beyond. Thank you for your generous support to this year's. **Our parish goal for 2026 is \$88,000**. Please, prayerfully consider making a pledge next week which you can fulfill throughout the year. Thank you.

SVDP FOOD PANTRY 2025 IMPACT SUMMARY

The SVDP Food Pantry experienced a banner year in 2025. **We served a total of 1,484 families, averaging 28.53 families per week. Over the course of the year, the pantry distributed 96,250 pounds of food. Using the national average value of \$2.05 per pound, the food provided represents an estimated retail value of \$197,314.** It is important to note that this figure reflects the value of the food distributed, not the actual cost to our pantry.

These figures clearly demonstrate the significant impact of the pantry in addressing food insecurity within our community. By meeting essential nutritional needs, the pantry enables families to redirect limited financial resources toward other critical expenses such as housing, utilities, and medical care.

Of course, none of this would be possible without the support of so many of our parishioners and others from outside the parish. We can't thank you enough for your tremendous generosity through financial contributions, food donations, volunteer time and prayers.

La despensa de alimentos SVDP experimentó un año excepcional en 2025. Atendimos a un total de 1,484 familias, con un promedio de 28.53 familias por semana. A lo largo del año, la despensa distribuyó 96,250 libras de alimentos. Utilizando el valor promedio nacional de \$2.05 por libra, los alimentos proporcionados representan un valor minorista estimado de \$197,314. Es importante señalar que esta cifra refleja el valor de los alimentos distribuidos, no el costo real para nuestra despensa. Estas cifras demuestran claramente el impacto significativo de la despensa en la lucha contra la inseguridad alimentaria dentro de nuestra comunidad. Al satisfacer las necesidades nutricionales esenciales, la despensa permite que las familias redirijan recursos financieros limitados hacia otros gastos críticos, como vivienda, servicios públicos y atención médica.

Por supuesto, nada de esto sería posible sin el apoyo de muchos de nuestros feligreses y de otras personas ajenas a la parroquia. No podemos agradecerles lo suficiente por su enorme generosidad a través de contribuciones financieras, donaciones de alimentos, tiempo como voluntarios y oraciones.
