DECREE

Having decreed the re-establishment of St. Michael Parish in the town of Dresden in the county of Kent in the province of Ontario (hereinafter referred to as *St. Michael Parish*), I, Ronald P. Fabbro, C.S.B., Bishop of London, having consulted with the Council of Priests of the Diocese of London on March 12, 2019, in accordance with canon 515, §2, do hereby decree that the territorial boundaries of the above-named St. Michael Parish shall hereinafter be as follows:

North:

Starting at Brigden Road east on McCallum Line to Mandaumin Road, then south on Mandaumin Road to a point halfway between Edys Mills Line and Bentpath Line, then east along that line to Forest Road.

East:

South on Forest Road to the Sydenham River then south along to Sydenham River to Sharrow Road, then south on Sharrow Road to Base Line Road (Wabash), then west on Base Line Road to Wabash Line, then southwest on Wabash Line to Kent Bridge Road, then southeast on Kent Bridge Road to Pioneer Line.

South:

Southwest on Pioneer Line to Lindsay Road, then north on Lindsay Road to Eberts Line, then southwest on Eberts Line to Centre Side Road, then north on Centre Side Road to Countryview Line, then west on Countryview Line to Caledonia Road, then north on Caledonia Road to Cedar Hedge Line, then west on Cedar Hedge Line to Prince Albert Road.

West:

At the intersection of Prince Albert Road and Cedar Hedge Line moving northwest on Prince Albert Road to Oldfield Line, then east on Oldfield Line to Centre Side Road, then north on Centre Side Road to Base Line Road, crossing Base Line Road to Tupperville Road, then north on Tupperville Road, both sides inclusive, to McCreary Line, then west to Brigden Road, then north on Brigden Road to McCallum Line.

Consequently, all Latin-rite Catholics domiciled within the above-described boundaries will be considered parishioners of the said St. Michael Parish.

This decree and its provisions shall come into effect on July 1, 2019

I direct that this decree be published in St. Michael Church in the town of Dresden in the county of Kent in the province of Ontario and by a suitable means throughout the Diocese of London, with the understanding that any who wish to make recourse against it, in accordance with canon 1734, §1-2, must do so in writing within ten (10) canonical days from the time this decree was lawfully notified.
