- Advent/Christmas at Christ the Redeemer is underway
 - Christmas card from Parish will be sent to parishioners with Mass times
 - Our Lady of Guadalupe service held on 12/11
 - There will not be an Advent reconciliation service this year
 - Christmas mass times are in the bulletin
 - Midnight mass will start at 11:00 pm and end at midnight this year
 - The Chalice will resume on the Epiphany of the Lord
- The next Spring Festival Advisory meeting is scheduled for 12/7
 - Sub-committees are about 50% staffed, but volunteers are still needed
 - Seeking sponsors for raffle tickets and t-shirt sales

- Advent outreach is in full swing; Our Mother of Mercy Toy Drive and Gift Cards for CAM is underway
- There were about 100 guests at the Volunteer Reception in early November
- Grotto & Prayer Garden design and development is underway
- The parish will transition to ParishStaq (parish information system)
 - A coach is working with different departments to move information and troubleshoot where there are issues
 - ParishStaq is a more powerful engine for the parish to connect the departments
- The first of three Confirmation I retreats was held the weekend of 12/3
- The Christmas Social will be held on 1/7 to celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany
