#### **PPC Matters**:

- Megan Dillingham Stewardship updates:
  - Tremendous response to Stewardship forms; 575 online forms filled out, with over 600 total responses between online and paper responses
  - There were discussions to add a stewardship weekend in early fall and a Service Day as part of Lent
  - DFS kicked off early February with a goal of \$335,000 by the end of 2023
  - Almsgiving project, to date, has raised over \$29,000
    - The project continues throughout Lent
    - On the third Sunday of Lent, there will be a QR code available to donate
  - o After Labor Day, parishioners will be encouraged to increase their offertory
- Megan Dillingham Spring Festival updates:
  - o Excellent progress has been made for the event, and the first committee lead meeting was held
  - o The new festival time:
    - 4/29 from 4:00 pm to 10:00 pm
    - 4/30 from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm, the raffle ticket pull will be at 5:00 pm and the 5:00 pm mass will be shifted to 6:30 pm
  - The Spring Festival kick-off will be 3/25 and 3/26
    - The kick-off will be held under the plaza where raffle tickets will be distributed, and festival shirts sold

- Volunteers will be needed, and PPC members are encouraged to assist
- Sign-up genius will be sent for other volunteer needs
- Event is moving to the back parking lot
- T-shirts are \$15/shirt, and online presale is currently open
- Sponsorships are open and available
- o Raffle tickets can be bought online, and the stub can be picked up in person from the church
  - Prizes this year will be various denominations of Visa gift cards
- Survey will be sent out after the event concludes
- o The young children's zone will be run by Genisis
- Bingo will be in the parish hall
- Water and soda donations will be accepted from parishioners
- Sign-up Genius will be sent to PPC members to sign-up for ticket booth shifts
  - Shifts will be 2 hours with 6-8 people per shift
- This year, raffle ticket booth will be separate from the event ticket booth
  - o These booths are the only place where money will be accepted
  - o There will be more security this year
  - o Price of ticket will be \$1, and wrist bands will be offered

## Information sharing from Fr. Sean:

- Parish Pilgrimage in September will travel to Cairo, Egypt, and the Holy Land
- The sculpture for the Prayer Garden is in the early stages of being created
  - Groundbreaking to happen after Spring Festival
- Religious Education planning to begin in April Pastoral Plan for Faith Formation
- Various future projects to help enhance the church:
  - Church chapel doors to be refurbished
  - St. Joseph window had a leak, and the wood framing was stained
  - Area by the candles to be redone as it is a fire and cleaning hazard. Removed wood shelves and replace with marble/stone shelves that are fireproof

#### **Open Discussion:**

- Ed EMHC how to increase the number of ministers as we increase the number of cups
  - o About 5,000 people attend mass
  - Calling forth of parishioners to share their gifts
- Installation of PPC members at either the same mass, or announced at each mass the PPC member attends
