

Christ the Redeemer Youth Ministry Code of Conduct

Recognizing the inherent dignity of each person, we hold each adult and student to a standard of Christian behavior. Everyone is here to grow, learn about themselves, connect with God so above all else, we expect each person to respect the people they come in contact with as well as the property. Students will cooperate and adhere to all directives given by adults. When students attend a CtRYM function, they will stay with the group at all times participating in the activities and events. Students will remain with the group until the published ending time unless they have approval from both the CtR staff and written permission from their parent or guardian. We ask that students participate in the activities of the night in ways that are appropriate to the situation: during games, to have fun and feel free to be silly; during talks and prayer, to be respectful and take it seriously.

Large Group

- Show respect by not causing disruptions and not talking unless called on to respond.
- Give your attention to the speaker(s) and not using an electronic device such as a smartphone, smartwatch, personal gaming system, tablet, camera, music player, etc. If you are observed using one of these devices, it will be taken from you.
- Keep your hands to yourself; use appropriate language.
- Treat the space with respect by not climbing or jumping on furniture and not running.
- Participate in prayer.

Transition to Small Group

- Stay seated until your small group is dismissed.
- Adhere to any instructions given by adults during the transition.
- Stay with your small group leader and walk as a group to your designated small group meeting space. Keep your hands to yourself during the transition.

Small Group

- Participate by sharing your thoughts and opinions.
- Respect others who may have differing viewpoints or opinions in your speech and actions.
- Sit where instructed and respect the items in the room that belong to others by not touching them.
- Stay on task and allow every member of your group to have an opportunity to share.

Dismissal

- Walk down the hallways to the exit.
- If your parents are parked in the back parking lot or in front of the church – walk to their vehicle.
- If your parent is in the Car Line, wait patiently in the appropriate place – do not cross the road or parking lot to meet them.
- Do not rough house with others.
