SCCs Explore “New Wine in New Wineskins” at Provincial Chapter



From February 14-18, 2019, the Sisters of Christian Charity held their 15th Provincial Chapter at Mallinckrodt Convent in Mendham. A Provincial Chapter is convened every six years to consider the religious spirit and the apostolic effectiveness of the province and to seek ways and means for an interior renewal of the individual Sister and of the entire province. Additionally, the Sisters elected delegates to represent them at their General Chapter to be held from July 1-22, 2019 in Paderborn, Germany.

The theme of the assembly was “New Wine in New Wineskins,” originating from the document, *New Wine in New Wineskins: The Consecrated Life and its Ongoing Challenges Since Vatican II*. The daily schedule included sacred conversations guided by Chapter facilitator, Sister Kathryn Clauss, IHM, Ph.D., and a Eucharistic Liturgy.

One of the unique aspects of this assembly was that, because of the Sisters’ May 2018 move to the new Motherhouse in Mendham, the entire Eastern Province could be gathered together under one roof. The closing liturgy was livestreamed on Facebook. It was viewed by people across the United States and in several different countries, especially those where the Sisters of Christian Charity serve.

Approximately 100 Companions of Pauline and Moderators gathered at Mallinckrodt Convent to celebrate their annual Covenant Day on April 28, 2019.

The majority of Companions renewed their Covenant while 23 made their Covenant for the first time. (see picture below)

The liturgy was celebrated by Father Hilary O'Leary, OSB, of St. Mary's Abbey, Morristown. He was assisted by Deacon James Jones, a Companion of Pauline, ordained for the Paterson Diocese.

Of special note were two new Companions, Carole Anstett and her daughter Lori Barse, both of Morgantown, PA. They are beginning a Companions group there. They know the SCC's from Wilkes-Barre and desire to bring Mother Pauline's spirit to Morgantown.

A presentation following dinner reflected on the "companions" of Blessed Pauline in her lifetime, and what they said about her. *Amiability* was the quality that quickly impressed those who knew her. The speaker, Sister Bernadette McCauley, is presently Vocation Director and Formater for the Postulants.

The Companions of Pauline are committed to living the charism of Blessed Pauline von Mallinckrodt, through prayer and works of charity, living the "Joy of the Gospel" as Pope Francis encouraged.

Mission Ambassador Initiative Proves Successful and Enriching

Mission Ambassadors are GHS employees who touch patients' lives through their service and spirit of caring. They reflect the mission, vision and values of GHS by acting as role models to co-workers, patients and guests, promoting human dignity, and meeting the physical and spiritual needs of patients and families. At present, there are 60 employees who volunteer as Mission Ambassadors.

Commitment to attend quarterly meetings and volunteer time to community organizations are key features of the Program. Some projects to date are: assembling "Blessing Bags" for the homeless in the area, supporting food drives, collecting school supplies for three Catholic elementary schools, and donating to various programs for veterans.

One notable service is the Brethren Housing Association Apartment Project in which apartments are cleaned, furnished and decorated and food provisions provided for families; most recently, for single moms with children.

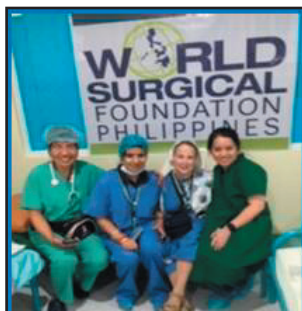
The impact of this new initiative, according to Sr. Mary Joseph, "is that the spirit of GHS is alive! Ambassadors are taking ownership for strengthening the program in their departments and it is increasing the bond between coworkers."

Lorica Award presented to Sister Romaine Niemeyer

On Sunday, March 31, at the Cathedral of St. Patrick, Harrisburg, PA, Bishop Ronald Gainer presented the



Lorica Award, named after the Lorica Prayer of St. Patrick, to Sr. Romaine Niemeyer, for commitment to the life of the Church in the Diocese of Harrisburg. Sister was recognized for her significant contributions as past president of Geisinger Holy Spirit Hospital and her integrity of faith and generosity of service. The Sisters of Holy Spirit Convent attended the Solemn Vesper Service where Sister received the Award.



Sister Martin Haubrich accompanied members of the World Surgical Foundation on a trip to the Philippine Islands. On returning Sister noted: "We have done over 300 minor surgeries and 72 major cases. The patients and their families are so grateful. They kiss your hand and give you wonderful hugs."

Mission Madero Group Journeys to Uganda

A summer initiative to travel to Uganda, sponsored by Morris Catholic High School, Denville, NJ, (MCHS) was an opportunity for special service and **Sr. John Paul Thorley, SCC, Math instructor at MCHS**, was eager to join Mission Madera's group of parents, students and teachers traveling with Sr. Cecilia Akol, LSOSF, (an Assumption College for Sisters graduate, 2018) to Soroti, Uganda from June 27-July 8.



Sister accompanied the group to help at three schools of the Little Sisters of St. Francis: St Ann's Girls' Primary School (950 students), and St. Francis' Primary and Secondary Schools for the Blind (180 students, primary through high school). These schools are specifically for the blind, a ministry particularly dear to Blessed Pauline.

Mission Madera's activities in the schools include: teaching, recreating with the children, painting and maintaining the buildings, working with the staff and community.

SCCs Give Service at Respite Center

Our Mission Statement calls us to "give and receive Christ's love, joy, peace and healing for the life of the world." **The SCC initial formation group and two of our Sisters, Sr. Marie Jose de la Rosa and Sr. Gabrielle Nguyen, offered service in June at the Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley Humanitarian Respite Center in McAllen, Texas.** Sr. Norma Pimentel, M.J., recipient of the prestigious *Laetare Medal*, is its executive director.

The Respite Center receives refugees that have been released from the nearby ICE Detention Center by bus, about 400-500 each day. The staff provides clothing, supplies, food, overnight shelter, kindness and a listening heart to these sisters and brothers from the south, who are en route to towns in the U.S., where families will help them to get a new start. Chaplains' Enrichment Day Held at GHS

At the annual Day of Professional Enrichment for Chaplains at Geisinger Holy Spirit Hospital (GHS), Sister Chris Koelhoeffer, IHM, presented "Greening Our Lives: Moving Towards Wholeness and Well-Being."

Sister Mary Joan Smith, SCC, Director of the Department of Spiritual Care at GHS focused for the past year on providing opportunities for Wellness and Work/Life Balance for both the Spiritual Care members as well as other staff members. This workshop was a culmination of that theme with a full day of reflection and enrichment.

According to Sister Chris: "We inhabit a world that is both beautiful and wounded. What can we do when the very service we offer taps so deeply into our reserves of compassion and energy?"

Sister's presentation to approximately 40 attendees offered, according to Sister Gabrielle Nguyen, a "chance to assess our energy and spirit, restore balance, and move us towards wholeness and well-being" making use of "prayer, reflection and sharing for our own nurturing and self-care."

Sister Mary Joan noted that "at the close of the workshop, many thanked me for having the day as it allowed them to give themselves permission to take time to replenish their own spirit by allowing God and His Spirit to nurture them."

Morris County CARES

On March 29, 2019, Morris County Sheriff James Gannon came to the Motherhouse to talk to the Sisters about support programs in place in this county to assist the homeless and those struggling with addiction. Sheriff Gannon has had past experience with the Department of Homeland Security and also the New York Police Department. *He spoke about the volunteer based CARES program: Center for Addiction Recovery, Education, and Success, located in Rockaway, NJ.* The Sheriff hopes that this will continue to reduce the number of arrests of homeless persons as well as be a support to those who have been incarcerated. Volunteers are always welcome to help in a variety of ways.

Lieutenant Denise Thornton and Corporal Erica Valvano expanded on Sheriff Gannon's talk, then escorted the Sisters through Hope One – the mobile access center that travels around the County equipped with meal vouchers, Narcan kits, and the opportunity for linkage to services including treatment, behavioral health services and more. On board Hope One is a Licensed Clinician, a Certified Peer Recovery Specialist and a plain clothes Police Officer to help those needing assistance. The Sisters are looking forward to assembling small items, toiletries, etc. in Blessing Bags to give to those on Hope One for distribution to the homeless.

Sheriff Gannon said at a recent breakfast meeting: "Hope One is wrapped around your loved ones. It is in our hearts and this is where we believe we can make a difference."

Bronx Community Makes a Difference

A coalition of parents, educators, students and members of the Bronx community came together to rally and petition the elected officials to clean up the drugs in the area around Immaculate Conception School to make the streets safe for the those who live and work there. Sr. Patrice Owens, SCC, principal, is pictured leading the rally. Sister's active leadership for the past 19 years is a response to the needs of an underserved community. The Take Back the Hub Committee meets regularly to organize rallies and demand resources that will improve the quality of life for the families who live in the community as well as provide resources for the marginalized.

Packing Food

On Saturday, March 16, all five Sisters from the Regional Center went to the Winnetka Community House. After handing in their event "tickets" and paying their \$26.93-per-person fee at the door the Sisters entered the gymnasium. (In addition to donating their time and energy, the Sisters had used some of their "treat" money to pay the event fee.) The participation fee would cover a portion of the cost of the food, packaging materials and shipping expenses. The Sisters' shift was scheduled for 11:00 am to 1:00 pm. At 11:00 everyone who would be working the 2nd shift gathered in a meeting room for a short speech and video presentation. The Sisters then went to Table 5 and took of their positions; they were among 400 participants - taking turns in three two-hour shifts - from all over the North Shore. During the day-long event 100,000 nutritious meals were packed for distribution to starving children in Nicaragua. The group at Table 5 managed to pack 16 boxes each containing 36 bags of rice casserole mix; each bag would feed six people. Cooked, warm samples of the rice dish were available at the completion of each shift for anyone who wanted to try it. All agreed that the finished product was quite tasty.

Novices Experience Mission



In the fall of 2018, our second-year novices, Sisters Graciela Colon (right) and Pauline Navarro journeyed to different convents and various ministries for a six-week mission experience.

Sr. Graciela lived with our Sisters at St. Elizabeth Convent, Bernardsville, NJ. Her ministries included assisting at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish and St. Elizabeth School, Bernardsville and working at the Religious Education Program of St. James Parish, Basking

Ridge, NJ. Sister also continued ministering as an immigration lawyer at Wind of the Spirit, Morristown, NJ providing services to undocumented immigrants helping them understand their legal situation. Sister said of her experience, "It was inspiring to see the ministries first-hand in which our Sisters are involved."

Sr. Paulina spent her time with our Sisters who teach at Morris Catholic HS, Denville, and live at St. Cecilia's Convent in Rockaway, NJ. Sister volunteered at Divine Mercy Academy, assisting as a teacher aide in various classes from Pre-K through 8th grade. In addition, she spoke to the 6th, 7th, and 8th graders about Blessed Pauline and vocations. "Everyone at Divine Mercy Academy was welcoming, and many expressed their appreciation of my presence. It was during this mission experience that I seriously considered the importance of education and discovered that I would like to pursue a degree in that field."

Both Sisters were grateful for the opportunity to live and connect with our Sisters on mission!

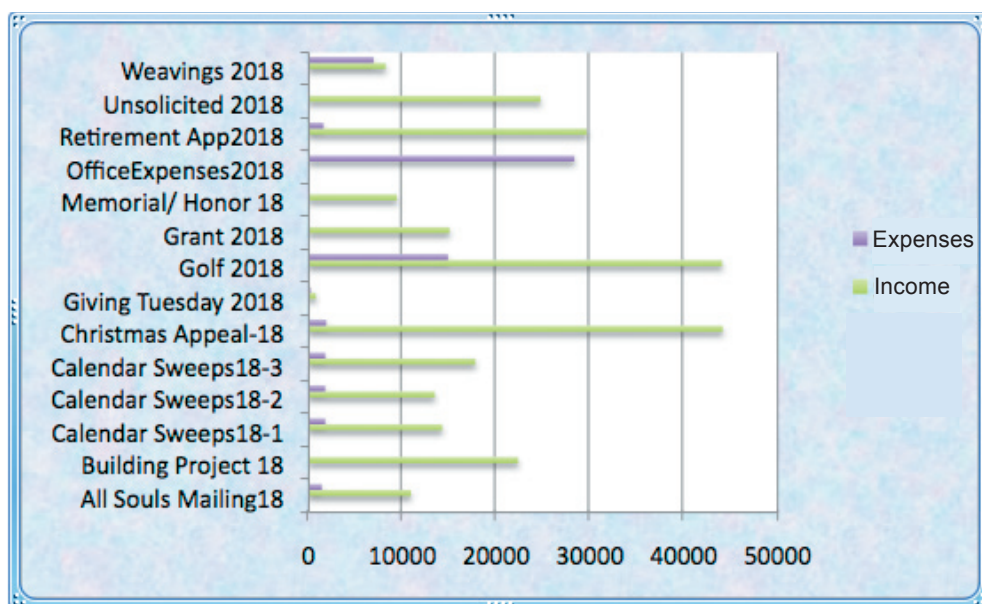
