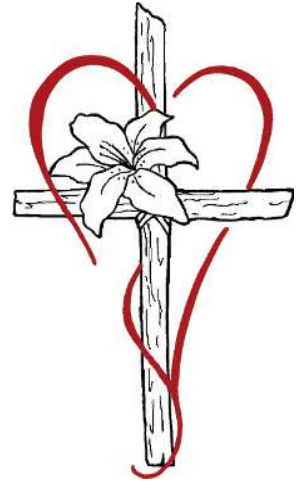

The labyrinth is a path on a large piece of cloth used for walking meditation, reflection and prayer that has ancient roots in our own faith tradition as well as other religious and spiritual traditions.

**On March 20th** you can stop by throughout the day or come to any of the special programs being offered. The walk takes about 30 minutes, but staying longer in the quiet space is encouraged.
