MON 12

Discuss the meaning of the word advocate and why Jesus used this word to describe for the Holy Spirit.

TUE 13

"The hand of the Lord was with them." Acts 11:21

Share ways the hand of the Lord strengthens you as a family as it did the first Christians.

VED 14

"I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." Jn 8:12

THU 15

Talk about the ways that your family is nourished through faith.

FRI 16

SAT 17

SUN 18

Discuss ways as a family that your actions demonstrate your faith more than words alone.

MON 19

Talk about ways that your family exemplifies the commandments.

TUE 20

"It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." Acts 14:22

Discuss ways your family perseveres in the faith even in difficult times.

VED 21

THU 22
