## Notes from Pastor Joe Wormek

Everyone will have the opportunity to participate in the Beyond Sunday Campaign at all Masses this weekend. John Vietmeier and I have been working with a representative from "Changing Our World" which is the fundraising company hired by the Roman Catholic Foundation. They are running this campaign to strengthen Catholic Education in our grade schools and high schools by offering scholarships to families. Part of the incentive for parishes to participate in the program was that 40% would be retained by the individual parish. According to my calendar, we actively started meeting in May. The amounts asked of our parishioners was based on one's Sunday envelope contributions. And those who we have no record of contributions, would also be asked for a gift.

The process started with personally asking a number of individuals for their campaign gift. For our parish, that group was almost three hundred households. I chose to visit a number of those families individually. I also invited some of those who responded to the campaign to be on the committee. And since both the parish and the school would benefit from this campaign, I invited the Parish Council and the PBOE to also help with these visits. The next group was mailed their material and received follow-up phone calls to answer any questions they might have. So by now the whole parish should have received their information and their requested gift to the campaign.

Parishioners' responses concerning the campaign have been varied. Some individuals gave more than what was asked of them, some gave their recommended amount, and some gave less than the suggested amount. Others decided that this campaign was not for them, but they would do something different for the parish itself.

The enlightening aspect of the campaign for me is how generous people are in this parish already. So many parishioners shared with me that they are already helping out other family members or the less fortunate. Every one of us has our priorities, and for many it is this parish of St. Francis Borgia. **We would not have all the programs & facilities of our parish without your generosity.**

Thank you for all you do.

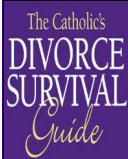

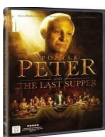
