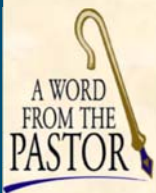

Thus, this special collection is providing for all the sisters who are in retirement. There are thousands across our country who need our care.

Wonder how Archdiocesan priests are taken care of these days? The parish is assessed an amount for every active Archdiocesan priest which covers all the retired priests. In addition, the annual collection during Easter assists those priests who live at Regina Cleri.

I pray in thanksgiving for all of you, as you are a blessing to us priests with thoughtfulness and generosity. I pray that the Lord will continue to bless you and your family throughout the year. We are all so blessed by the Lord. We have scheduled two masses at 7:00 a.m. & 9:00 a.m. Thanksgiving Day so that you have the opportunity to personally thank the Lord through the Eucharist.

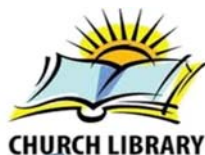

*Thank you for mistakes you have allowed me make so I can learn to do things better.*

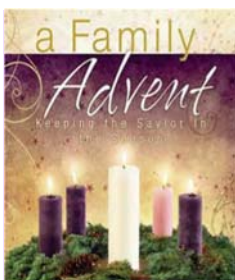
*Thank you for fear that heightens my awareness of dependency on you.*

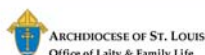
