
collection boxes and there are some extra envelopes in the pews. Please put the envelope or cash in basket at the entrance of Church today. Thank you!

Act of Consecration to Saint Joseph What does it mean for a person to be

O Glorious Patriarch and Protector of Holy Church! O Most Chaste Spouse of the Virgin Mother of God! O Guardian and Virginal Father of the Word Incarnate! In the presence of Jesus and Mary, we, the clergy, religious, and lay faithful of the Diocese of Tulsa and Eastern Oklahoma, choose you this day to be our father, guardian, and protector.

O Saint Joseph, Pillar of Families, whom God has made the Head of the Holy Family, accept us, we beseech you, though utterly unworthy, to be members of your "Holy House." Present us to your Immaculate Spouse; ask her also to adopt us as her children. With her, pray that we may constantly think of Jesus, and serve him faithfully to the end of our lives. O Terror of Demons, increase in us virtue, protect us from the evil one, and help us not to offend God in any way.

O Spiritual Father, Most Faithful, we hereby consecrate the Diocese of Tulsa and Eastern Oklahoma to your Most Chaste Heart. In faithful imitation of Jesus and Mary, we place all our concerns under your care and protection. To you, after Jesus and Mary, we consecrate our bodies and souls, with all their faculties, our spiritual growth, our homes, and all our affairs and undertakings.



America Needs Fatima is a campaign to capture the heart and soul of America with the Message of Our Lady of Fatima. In 1917, Our Lady appeared at Fatima to three young seers with a message of warning and hope for humanity. If the world did not convert, the Blessed Mother said there would be much suffering, famines and wars. To avert such disasters, Our Lady asked for prayer, penance and other measures. She also promised that: "Finally, my Immaculate Heart will triumph.'

Today, Our Lady's message is timelier than ever in light of the many sins of men and the turning away from the Faith. The America Needs Fatima campaign is dedicated to bringing this urgent message into people's homes and to the public square. This is done by the home visitation program, in which a statue of Our Lady visits thousands of private homes yearly. America Needs Fatima distributes millions of rosaries, devotional items and calendars. Other activities include Public Square Rosary Rallies, publications, e-mail campaigns and protests against blasphemies.

The Five First Saturdays devotion is one of the principal points of the Fatima message. It centers on the urgent need for mankind to offer reparation and expiate for the many injuries that the Immaculate Heart of Mary suffers from the hands of both impious and indifferent men.

On the First Saturday during *Five* (5) Consecutive Months, the Devotion consists of:

- 1. Going to Confession,
- 2. Receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion,
- 3. Saying five decades of the Rosary,
- 4. Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary. All this offered in REPARATION for the sins of blasphemy and ingratitude committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
