In the Eucharist, he is right in front of you.

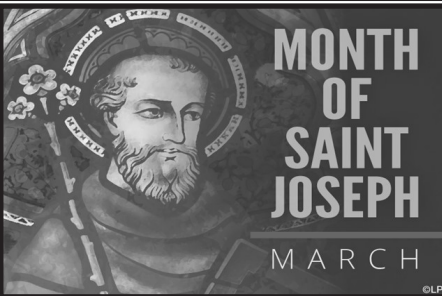

It is not too late to sign-up Please call the office: 918.423.6695 for more information. Volunteering during Mass is a beautiful way to share your Faith and Gifts.

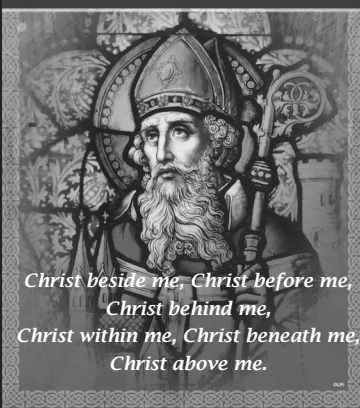
