This upcoming week is designated National Marriage Week (February 7-14). It is opportunity to focus on building a culture of life and love that brings with supporting and promoting marriage and family. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has provided a Couple's Novena. Below is the prayer text. Let us all join together and pray this novena.

Day 1~February 5

For engaged and civilly married couples preparing to receive the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony; that God may grant them the gift of joy and wisdom bring this time of discernment. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...Sts. Joseph & Mary, pray for us!*

Day 2~February 6

For empty nesters and retired couples; that this new phase in their lives may bring renewal in their relationship. May they be inspired to share their time and gifts with those in need, especially young and struggling couples. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...Sts. Joachim & Anne, pray for us!*

Day 3~February 7

For couples experiencing the pain of infertility and child loss; that our Blessed Lord may grant healing, acceptance, and meaning, and inspire them in ways to see their gift of love to give to others. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...Sts. Zechariah & Elizabeth, pray for us!*

Day 4~February 8

For couples strained by a difficult relationship with their child(ren) or family members; that they may seek opportunities to show empathy and forgiveness in the hope of reconciliation. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...Sts. Louis & Zelle Martin, pray for us!*

Day 5~February 9

For couples experiencing physical or mental illness; that through the virtues of patience and endurance, they may remain faithful to the vow to be true to one another "in sickness and in health," and that they may be surrounded by support of family and friends. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...St. Gianna Beretta Molla, pray for us!*

Day 6~February 10

For couples struggling with addiction of any kind- alcohol, drugs, pornography, social media, work, shopping, gambling-that the Lord may reveal and heal the wound or unmet need that is at the source of the addiction. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...St. Rita of Cascia, pray for us!*

Day 7~February 11

For separated couples and those recovering from infidelity; that where separation is absolutely necessary, both parties may find safety and healing, while remaining true to their vows and open to reconciliation. We pray that through the power of Jesus' resurrection, honest, trust, and tenderness may be restored in couples recovering from infidelity. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...St. Thomas More, pray for us!*

Day 8~February 12

For couples that do not share the same faith; that through the practice of virtue, they may be joined in their pursuit of the true, the good, and the beautiful. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...St. Monica, pray for us!*

Day 9~February 13

For all couples faithfully living out their vocation to be light in the world; may they know that their efforts, however small, are making God's love known to those around them. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory Be...Sts. Aquila and Priscilla, pray for us!*

Day 10~February 14 (Closing prayer)

O God, You created marriage to be the crown of creation, the holy place where love dwells, and where new life is nourished. Confirm couples in their sacred duty to be light and salt to the world through the gift of love You have given them. Through Jesus' Sacred Heart,

increase in all couple's empathy, joy, tenderness, and mercy. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, protect couples from apathy, resentment, infidelity, and contempt. God our Father, Who made all things good, help couples to never lose sight of their dignity, even in the midst of conflict, temptation and despair. We ask this through our Lord, Jesus Christ. Amen.
